



From the Pastor's Desk

"Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?" The recognition of God's presence and giving thanks for the gifts he gives is at the heart of the Gospel message this day. Jesus heals ten lepers and yet only one returns to thank him. It raises the question were the others not appreciative of the gift or did they just not realize that giving thanks was in order? This story should help us to realize what we owe to God and the proper response that is due.

God is constantly at work in our lives. He is always seeking to reach out to bring us healing and blessings. The question is do we recognize it or maybe more importantly are we even looking for it? How often have we prayed for God to intervene in our lives and then fail to see him? 


