TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends,

October 9 is the Feast Day of St. John Henry Newman. We are blessed to have a magnificent icon of this important figure in the life of the church, who is also a patron saint of university students. It was completed and installed during the Covid shutdown, so many may not yet have had a good look at it. It is in the transept on the right side of the altar, directly across from the statue of St. Patrick and next to the small chancel organ and image of Our Lady of Lourdes. I would encourage you to come and pray there. Also, pick up a copy of the sheet containing the great description of Newman's life which Fr. George has penned for us.

With that, on October 8, we celebrate the memorial of our friend, Professor Chip Piatti, on the first anniversary of his death. Chip designed the icon of Newman and its frame; this work was his final contribution in helping us to renovate our beautiful church. RIP, Chip!

We were delighted to welcome former pastor and respected scholar **Fr. Bryan Hehir** back to St. Paul's last Sunday for the first of two lectures. Part II is October 31. Many thanks to all those who have prepared this occasion!

We have begun again our seasonal, **sung Thursday Vespers with the Choir Boys at 5:30pm in the main church.** If you've never had the opportunity to pray in this way, I strongly encourage you to join us, and to bring many along with you! It's a perfect way for Catholics and non-Catholics alike to benefit from this experience! Vespers lasts for about a half hour and provides an opportunity for peace and reflection as we come together for meditative music and quiet after a long day. I do hope you can join us!

I've been mentioning the **Parish Grand Annual Collection** that will take place on November 13/14. Again, there will be a letter with more information coming, but the Parish Council wisely recommended that I keep this in front of you with plenty of notice so that you might plan for the best way to make this sacrificial offering for the care and well-being of the parish.

October is a month with special devotion to our Blessed Mother. Turn to her so that she can bring you into a yet deeper relationship with her Son, Jesus. Mary, Mother of God, pray for us!
