Dear Friends,

October is a month filled with feasts and memorials of **truly great saints**: Therese of Lisieux, Francis of Assisi, Pope John Paul II among many others. I invite you to look at a liturgical calendar and find your own favorite! **October is also a month with special devotion to our Blessed Mother**. Turn to her so that she can bring you into a yet deeper relationship with her Son, Jesus. Mary, Mother of God, pray for us!

With that, on October 17, we celebrate what would have been the 109th birthday of **Dr. Theodore Marier**, founder of our St. Paul's Choir School and renowned scholar of sacred music. He was also recognized as a man of enormous faith and zeal for the mission of the Catholic church. We pray for him and ask his intercession for us here at St. Paul's.

We have begun again our seasonal, **sung Thursday Vespers with the Choir Boys at 5:30pm in the main church**. I'll be away from the parish visiting with a friend who is on sabbatical; this has been in the planning for three years, so I'm happy that Covid restrictions have eased a bit! I am grateful to Fr. George and Fr. Patrick and the staff for taking on extra duties while I am away.

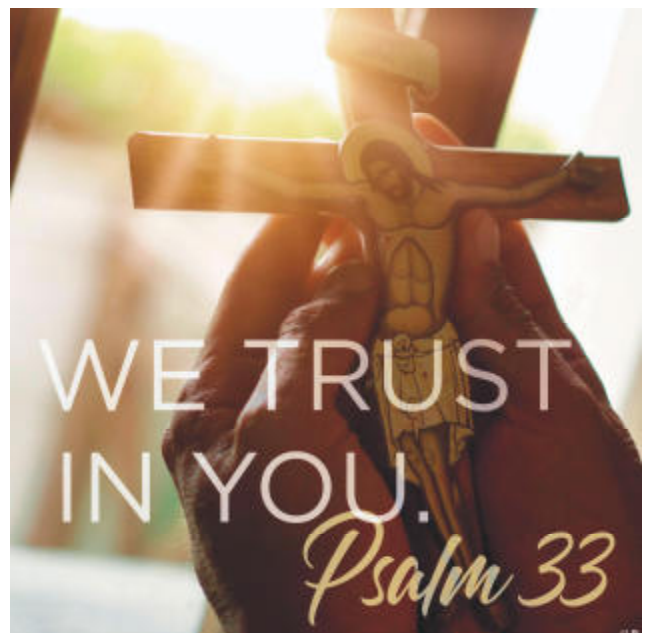
