James Brent OP from the Dominican House of Studies in Washington DC, will be preaching on "The Father's House."

On the faith formation side of things, our RCIA program currently has a record 36 candidates in formation for Christian Initiation and entrance into full communion with the Catholic Church! The group is approximately a quarter undergraduate students, half graduate students, and a quarter local professionals.

Over the past few months, dozens of you have asked me "When is your next performance!?" At the risk of shameless self-promotion, I'm excited to announce that my jazz-funk quartet, Vatican III, will return to St. Paul's on Friday, November 12, 7:30pm-9:30pm. As the lower church hall will be transformed into a jazz club for the evening, it is my hope that this event will provide a unique opportunity to bring together the many different parts of our St. Paul's Community for a casual, fun evening. All parishioners, students, and families are welcome. It will be \$5/person, \$10/family, and with a cash bar. It's our first live performance in 2 years, but we've been practicing hard and are very much looking forward to it!

Due to my absence this weekend for the undergrad retreat, as well as Fr. George being away for Masses off campus, we're happy to welcome Fr. David Barnes and Fr. Peter Stamm, both from St. John's Seminary, who will be covering confessions and some Masses this weekend.
