THE RETURN OF ADORATION TO SACRED HEARTS



Dear Friends in Christ,

It has been a whirlwind of blessings this past summer and we are very excited to welcome all our students and families to a new year of faith formation. They have been inspiring witnesses in keeping the faith alive through an unusual year. We are thankful we have the support and resources to offer in-person learning.

Witness is a key word to what Catechetical Sunday is all about. On Sunday, September 19th, the Catholic Church recognizes the significant role catechists make in “creating and fostering a culture of witness,” to the Gospel. To witness the Gospel gives evidence in our words and actions in sharing the faith, hope, and love of Jesus Christ. We witness based on an experience or an observation which has taken place on our hearts and minds with the *living* God. Giving witness to the Gospel is not something stagnant or one isolated incident. Rather, to witness the Word of God is being alive, breathing, acting, and fully moved by the works of the Holy Spirit.

By virtue of our Baptism, we are all called and entrusted with the sacred duties of *teaching the faith*. First and foremost, this begins with the “domestic church,” our immediate families. Parents, guardians, grandparents, foster parents, aunts, and uncles are the first witnesses of living the faith. Secondly, the greater community of pastors, catechists, and religion teachers seek to provide opportunities for sacraments, religious study, acts of service, and prayer experiences. As a parish community, we are here to support you and your families in the great task of educating our young people by faith. The challenges and demand of time are many for our families today. More than ever, our young families need support, prayers, and an outpouring of continued love and affirmation.

The theme for Catechetical Sunday 2021 is taken from the prayer we express during the Liturgy of the Eucharist: “*Say the Word and My Soul Shall Be Healed.*” From the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops: “The past year has highlighted the urgent need for healing - physical, spiritual, emotional - in ourselves and in our world. As our world struggles to heal, complete healing is not possible without Jesus as the Divine Physician. When our souls heal, all heals, despite our suffering (uscgb.org © 2021).” Given what we have endured and resiliently forged through, healing is paramount in the health and wellness of our spiritual community. When we humbly recognize our need for healing, we can courageously ask Jesus to heal us of our infirmities. As a healed person, we can see the world from a different perspective and treat others with greater compassion.

In the Gospel from Mark, Jesus calls our attention to an area we may need much healing. Why do we need to feel greater than another? Why do we insist on being the “first” at things? Why do we feel we are in competition with another? The healing we need in this instance is from our poor sense of self-worth. If we truly believe we are created in the image of God, then all our unique gifts and attributes are pieces of a grand masterpiece. *There are no lesser than parts.* The world has its own standards of what is great and Jesus’ message turns the ego-centric view upside down. Jesus draws a child to the center of attention, those who are most vulnerable in our communities and says to His disciples: “if anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all...whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me, but the One who sent me.”

May we as a faith community never cease to seek the Divine Physician for healing and seek to foster an experience of faith, hope, and love among those we meet. Special care and blessing to those who teach and witness the faith. Happy Catechetical Sunday!

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that the existence of **angels** has always been taught by the Catholic Church? Angels, while spiritual beings, were created with intelligence and free will. There are many references to angels in both the Old Testament as well as the New Testament where Jesus spoke of them several times. We have all heard the accounts in the Gospels of Mary's encounter with the angel Gabriel at the Annunciation, the presence of a multitude of angels at Christ's birth in Bethlehem, and their appearance at Christ's empty tomb. The Church celebrates the angels and honors them with two feast days, the **Feast of Saints Michael, Gabriel, and Rafael** (the Archangels) on September 29th and the **Feast of the Guardian Angels** on October 2nd. The Church encourages each of us to cultivate through prayer a relationship with our own guardian angels, and it is comforting to know that these powerful helpmates are close by whenever we need to call upon them.
