POINTS TO PONDER

Reflect on Sunday's readings: John 21:1-19 Acts 5:27-32, 40b-41; Revelations 5:11-14

- Is there someone in your life worth jumping out of a boat to hug? How does it feel to know that Jesus would do this for you?
- Have you ever felt you failed at something so badly, you could not possibly try it again? Viewing Peter's transformation through this framework of overcoming what appears to be total failure, can you imagine a situation in which you might revisit your "failed" work?
- What is one example of when the Lord was your helper (as opposed to the other way around)?
- Have you ever had your grief turned into dancing? What was the "dancing"?

"... I proclaimed God's word and gave testimony to Jesus..."

The Apostle John was exiled on the island of Patmos because of Christian persecution pursued by the Roman emperor Domition. The island is situated off the west coast of present-day Turkey where today it is a picturesque Greek isle attracting tourists and pilgrims. During John's stay it was a place to be isolated like an open- air prison.

John experienced a series of eight visions which in written form are known as the Revelation. The first vision embodied in today's second reading was the "revelation" of Jesus to the seven churches organized at that time. Christianity during Domition's rule, AD 81-96, was still in its infancy and various, regional churches had organized. The Apostle Paul's letter revealed the dysfunction and his attempts to coordinate a commonly shared theology and attempts to resolve conflicts within and among the various churches.

Whether John had dreams or transcended into deep meditative phases, the eight "visions" revealed God's ultimate plan for humanity with Jesus at the center. John was very familiar with Jesus teachings and witnessed the transfiguration and ascension.

Undoubtedly, his writings which became know as Revelation - are the most complex and to some viewers, bewildering of the scriptures. But with some guidance by praying to the Holy Spirit to intervene in strengthening our understanding and committed study, the beautiful salvation history planned by God and how it will ultimately be fulfilled can be richly rewarding.

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that on the Sunday following Easter Sunday (this year April 24th) the Church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday? During his homily at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000, Pope John Paul II announced that henceforth the Sunday following Easter would be referred to by this title. St. Faustina had been born Helena Kowalska into a family of Polish peasants in 1905. She entered religious life as part of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in 1925 and was known there as Sr. Maria Faustina. She lived a quiet and apparently unassuming life, but this was by appearances only, as she was gifted with an amazing interior life of intimate prayer with Christ, who revealed to her His message of divine mercy. Sr. Faustina recorded her conversations with Christ in her diary, Divine Mercy in My Soul, which details Christ's longing for all mankind to turn to Him in love and trust to receive His great gift of mercy.


