*Following Jesus Brings Great Rewards!*

This theme is beautifully illustrated in the children’s book, *The Cross in The Egg* by Shirley Taylor, as well as in today’s Gospel.

In *The Cross in The Egg*, we follow a rabbit who lives in the garden of Gethsemane. He witnesses Jesus praying in the garden after having eaten the Last Supper. Jesus slowly reaches toward Rabbit and touches the place where one of His tears has fallen. Rabbit’s heart is filled with joy and love. Rabbit fills a basket with colorful eggs and sets out to find Jesus in Jerusalem, so that he can present him with this gift, to make Him happy. Rabbit learns that Jesus has been crucified and buried. He is confused and heartbroken when he visits the empty tomb. A voice tells Rabbit, “Do not be afraid, Jesus has been raised from the tomb.” Rabbit learns that by following Jesus, he has received the one gift, or reward that Jesus treasures more than any other, he opened his heart to receive His love. Therefore, Jesus is with him always.

In today’s Gospel, Jesus reveals himself to his disciples at the Sea of Tiberias, as they have great success in catching one hundred fifty-three fish. Jesus had told them to put their net on the right side of the boat, and when they lifted it out of the water, they received a great reward! What would have happened if the disciples had not listened to Jesus, and didn’t put their net on the right side of the boat? They would have missed out on a wonderful breakfast with the risen Lord! When we follow and listen to Jesus, we feel excited and happy! Other people will see how excited and happy we are and will want to be just like us and follow Jesus too. Jesus is inside of our hearts, and He wants to give us many blessings. By listening to and following Jesus, wonderful blessings and rewards will come to us every day!

This weekend’s second collection is for Sacred Hearts Parish Building and Maintenance. Thank you for your generous support of this collection which allows us to keep our property in good condition.



**DID YOU KNOW?**

Did you know that May is the month when the Catholic Church honors the **Blessed Virgin Mary** in a special way? This practice of honoring our Blessed Mother during May arose in the 13th century possibly with the intent of Christianizing popular secular feasts being celebrated at that time. By the 16th century, books extolling this devotion could be found, and by the 18th

century it had become especially popular with and spread by the Jesuit Order. Over the centuries, many popes have recommended and encouraged this pious practice, including during more recent times, Pope Pius XII, who referenced it in his great encyclical, *Mediator Dei* ("On the Sacred Liturgy," 1947), and Pope Paul VI in his short encyclical dedicated entirely to the subject, *Mense Maio* ("The Month of May," 1965). Suggested ways the faithful can honor Mary this month are praying the Rosary, the Regina Coeli, and Marian litanies; making May shrines in their homes using flowers and a statue of Mary, or making a local pilgrimage to a site dedicated to Mary or containing her likeness in statue or painting.

Visit Marian sites at Sacred Hearts Parish: statues inside St. Patrick Church and Sacred Hearts Church, the Marian Grotto outside Sacred Hearts Church, and outside in front of the ECC and St. Patrick Church.

Many thanks for your support of Sacred Hearts Parish. Here are the financial numbers for the Offertories, Grand Annual and Faith Formation revenues for the first nine months of the fiscal year. Once again this year, the Grand Annual is very strong. Our Faith Formation revenue is below budget due to fewer students enrolled in the program this year. We are pleased with our improved offertories. We have seen a significant increase in our Building and Maintenance collection each month. Our offertories are 8% above last year. We closely monitor our budget and still believe that we will finish the 2021-2022 fiscal year in a positive manner. I will keep you updated on financial matters as warranted. Blessings and peace.
