Greetings Sacred Hearts Parishioners,

In today's readings we see a beautiful connection between the Old Testament and the New Testament. We have Moses, from the Book of Deuteronomy reminding his followers that they should, "Love the Lord, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength." And in today's Gospel, Jesus quotes this verse to the scribes, repeating, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength."

The message is the same one handed down to Moses from God the Father, and the other from the mouth of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. No matter who we are, or from where in the Bible we draw inspiration, the message is clear. We should be fully focused on our faith in the Lord, and we should commit fully to Him. We cannot dabble in loving God, we cannot dabble in committing to our faith. We must jump in with both feet! We must love God with everything we have. We must devote ourselves to being faithful followers with all the energy and focus we can muster.

The lessons from both these readings in Deuteronomy and from Mark, are lessons that we can apply to our own lives. We must fully commit to being the best husband or wife we can be. We must fully commit to being the best parent we can be. We must fully commit to being the best educators we can be. What wonderful reminders guiding us to live our lives fully in the Spirit of the Lord!



(Eph 1:5, Catechism of the Catholic Church 1265) And as adopted sons of the Father, we are called to become heirs of Christ Himself. (Gal 4:1-7) Jesus Christ came as a leader – the Son of God, but also as *image of the Father*. (Col 1:15) We ourselves also bear that image (Gen 1:27). Why is this important? We have been called in Christ to be a part of the mission that makes present the *true image* of the hidden, humble, meek, loving, and no less powerful Father. To be in Communion with Him. To receive the hope He gives us as fathers and sons, and to share that hope with others by the way we live our lives. We will begin with a Consecration to the righteous father whom God chose to raise His only begotten Son – St. Joseph. Important information:

Did You Know?

Did you know that in our Catholic Church the month of November is dedicated in a special way to the **Holy Souls in Purgatory**? After celebrating All Saints' Day on November 1st, when the Church honors all the souls who have attained Heaven, on November 2nd we then observe **All Souls' Day**, praying for all the souls in Purgatory. Scripture tells us that nothing unclean can enter Heaven (Rev. 21:27), so while many souls die in God's grace and through his mercy will enjoy eternal salvation, they must be purified first from the effects of their earthly sins. As part of the Communion of Saints, the Catholic faithful have the responsibility to pray for these souls that they may be cleansed and attain the joy of seeing God face-to-face. The Church extends throughout the month of November this work of mercy of praying for the dead. In 2 Maccabees 12:45-46 we read that praying for the dead is "a good and pious thought..." and makes atonement for the dead "that they might be absolved from their sin."




