#### Dear Friends:

Many thanks to all who participated in last week's celebration for the Blessing of the Altar. I am grateful to our donors who provided their gifts, the musicians and servers for their service at the liturgy, and those who provided hospitality at the parish hall. So many of you expressed your appreciation for the liturgy and remarked on how good it was to be back in our parish center.

All are pleased with our new Altar and the beauty of the Church. Some have noticed that the lighting has changed. Along with the installation of lights over the stained glass in the Apse above the altar, new lighting was installed in the nave of the Church. LED lighting, while expensive to install, will provide both longevity and efficiency going forward. Also, dimmer switches were installed to provide options for evening celebrations. New sconces will need to be installed at the entrance to the Church as there are issues with the fixtures.

I also wish, in time, to upgrade the exterior lights at the entrances to something more reliable. These currently have motion sensors and light up upon proximity to the entrances. The problem with this is that the entrances are otherwise dark in the evening, and one has to walk a significant way in the dark before the sensors detect motion. This in my estimation is problematic. Firstly, it is a hazard. Secondly, if there is an evening event at the Church, a dark exterior is altogether unwelcoming and might even lead one to think the event is cancelled. If something is "going on" at the Church...the lights should be on. Thirdly, I have concerns regarding security. When nothing is going on, the campus is dark. Individuals have spotted parked cars during dark hours and suspicious activity...individuals roaming about without purpose. The authorities have been notified with the assurance of monitoring. All that said, the exterior lighting will be addressed.

I continue that thank you for your generous contributions which have been meeting projection overall. We could use donations for the upgrades we are making...lighting, the parish center, and heating repairs...more to come on these.
