Dear Friends:

In reviewing the First and Second Quarter finances, I am pleased to inform you that St. Raphael's Parish continues to operate in the black. Contributions and Donations have been generous and Offertory Giving exceeds projections thus far. This is due to your Devotion to God, love of your parish, and sacrifice. Such positions us to make the improvements, even if only incrementally, that are necessary to our parish life. Nearly \$10,000.00 has been paid in heating repairs which includes two new circulator pumps...one for the Church and the other for the Center. The two others will likely need replacement. Other improvements will be needed...the thermostats are dated and unreliable.

The Center continues with ongoing assessment. New countertops have been added together with a new sink. A center Island countertop awaits installation. The old counters were peeling. The new counters will allow for safer food preparation. I am preparing a new meeting room in which new carpeting has been installed over failed tiles. It is my hope to do each side room one by one and finally address the entire facility. The meeting room has been painted as will the other rooms and main body need painting. Next, the kitchen will be painted. The wood floor will eventually need a screening and recoat. We recently had a failed valve in one of the washrooms which caused minor flooding, and this has been addressed.

To repeat last week's comments somewhat, all are pleased with our new Altar and the beauty of the Church. New LED lighting has been installed with dimmer switches. Also, each of the nave shrines have been illumined to add to devotion and prayer. New sconces will need to be installed at the entrance to the Church as there are issues with the fixtures. I also mentioned the need to upgrade the exterior lighting for the purposes of practicality, safety, and security. I am conferring with the electrician.

Once again, all this has been done and continues with your financial and volunteer support. Lastly, as my main attention is always our Church, I will accept donations for new Altar cloths for the side and High Altars as these are showing signs of wear. Peace, Fr.
