

Lenten Fasting Guidelines

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 on.

ST MATTHEW ORATORY, WEST CASTLETON, VT

After prayerful consideration, Bishop Coyne weighing the reasons and causes, has decided the following:

- 1. St. Matthew Oratory, Avalon Beach, West Castleton, Vermont, is hereby reduced to profane but not sordid use according to the prescripts ofc. 1224 §2 for the grave causes mentioned above.
- 2. The separate process for alienation (aka sale) will commence.
- 3. Prior to any possible alienation, all sacred objects, relics, sacred furnishing, stained-glass windows, bells, confessionals, altars, etc. would be removed for use in other sacred edifices or stored in ecclesiastical custody.

The Bishop's Decree is posted in the vestibule of this Church.

ST ANN PARISH, MIDDLETOWN SPRINGS, VT

On November 29, 2022, the Presbyteral Council of the diocese was heard and determined that St. Ann Parish in Middletown Springs, Vermont, be suppressed. The people are under the spiritual care of St. Raphael's Church in Poultney to which the goods and obligations of St. Ann Parish will belong. The Bishop's Decree becomes effective on February 22, 2023.

ST. FRANCES CABRINI, WEST PAWLET, VT

On November 29, 2022, the Presbyteral Council of the diocese was heard and determined that St. Frances Cabrini Parish, West Pawlet, Vermont, be suppressed. The people are under the spiritual care of Our Lady of Seven Dolors Parish, in Fair Haven to which the goods and obligations of St. Frances Cabrini Parish will belong. The Bishop's Decree becomes effective on February 22, 2023.

7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Of all the things Jesus says which seem totally bat-crazy, this one might take the cake: "But I say to you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you." An enemy is someone who desires the destruction of you, your projects, or those you care about. To love and pray for them is to want their health, strength, and flourishing. But if they thrive, they are more likely to hurt you and others. So, aren't you indirectly willing your own destruction, or that of your friends? If you doubt that this problem is embedded in this teaching, when was the last time you actually prayed honestly for the people you really hate?

How can we solve this riddle so we might actually live this command? Recall that enemy-love is the surest sign that you love someone with God's love, and not with indirect egotism. After all, if my love for my enemy ends up hurting me or my loved ones, it can't be for me. Enemy-love costs more because there are no tit-for-tats. No reciprocity — just love poured out, and often pain in return. That's why it is so precious and rare. "What is unusual about that?" asks the Lord about love for our friends. Jesus wants us to experience the unusual love which only comes from him.

When Jesus was being killed on the cross, he was loving his executioners. In fact, he was holding them in being as they nailed him to the cross. He loved those who were spiritually piercing his Mother's heart, while they were doing it. And when he rose from the dead, he showed us that this kind of love is always worth it. It's stronger than death. Real love is unusual.
