MASS SCHEDULE: Monday through Saturday: daily Mass starts at 8:15 AM. Sunday Masses: 4:30 PM (Vigil Mass, Sat. evenings) 8:00 AM, 9:30 AM (St. Louis) 11:00 AM; and 4:00 PM.

Before coming to Mass, wash your hands for 20 seconds using soap and water.

Please do not enter the Church without a face mask.
