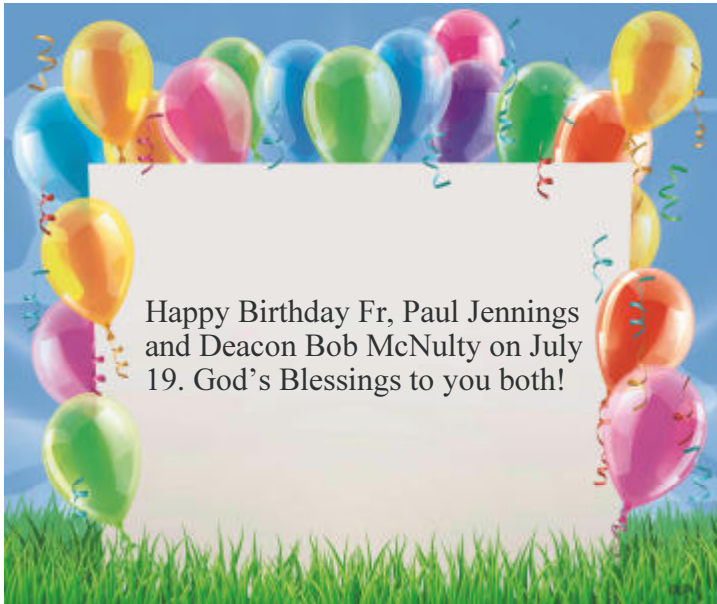

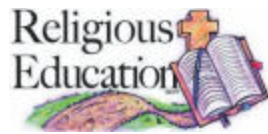

The Lord Is My Shepherd (Reflection, PS 23)

Psalm 23 is one of the most familiar Psalms for all Christians. Images of the sheep and shepherd are represented throughout art, music, and regularly printed on prayer cards. The Psalms are our response to God in times of sorrow, joy, thanksgiving, and praise. When we learn to pray with the Psalms, we enter into conversation with God, and by His Word, we hear the voice of our Good Shepherd. Psalm 23 is often sung or recited at funeral celebrations, and reflects our total surrender and dependence on God's goodness and pity on us. It expresses our hope for eternal life, and our need for surrender to God here on Earth. The shepherd is aware of the land on which the sheep graze, leading them from pasture to pasture in search of food; God provides the grace and sustenance for every moment of our lives. In Him we lack for nothing. Trusting in God's Will, He hears and answers our needs with abundant goodness. In our times of distress, fear, anxiety, or loneliness, Jesus longs to meet us where we are and lead us to a place of peace. As we grow in discipleship our reliance on Scripture becomes necessary. Let us ask the Holy Spirit for guidance to read and pray with Scripture. Just as Jesus invited His apostles to come away with Him and rest, He invites us to enter into committed daily prayer and the Eucharist, renewing ourselves to continue the work of the Father. As we find encouragement in the Scripture, especially the Psalms, may we be strengthened to share what God is doing in our lives with others. May we always find our hope in Christ, the Good Shepherd.
