### THE VICE WAY OR THE WISE WAY

In the Gospel reading today, we encounter two extremely opposing responses to the birth of Jesus. On one hand we read, "When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled," on the other hand we also read, "they were overjoyed at seeing the star". What could be the cause of such deviation between the wise men and Herod.

The best way to explore the mystery behind this, is to look deep within ourselves and reflect on our own life story. Sacred scripture is the word of God, which may speak of a historical event, but its purpose is to enlighten our life, with its power to transform everything for good.

In life it is our experience that when our favourite team holds the Vince Lombardi Trophy, we are overjoyed. But when the opposite team holds it, we are greatly troubled. To become overjoyed or to be greatly troubled is there any connections with the team or the cup or the match at all? Absolutely nothing. But it all has to do with, who I am? What is my attitude to sports? What makes me to like one team and dislike another? Why do I give such power to this fleeting fake fame?

My reaction to the outcome of the match may be, there is something deep within me that craves for recognition, name, fame, appreciation, and success. When I am not able to satisfy this deep hunger on my own, I join a club and try to share that fake fame for a while to alleviate my hunger for greatness. We all know that such affiliation with fast passing fake greatness only makes us more miserable than ever. The life of Herod is the best example for it.

There is another way. Like the wisemen we can travel out of ourselves to seek and help the needy and the vulnerable. We can offer ourselves as gift to uphold life, love, justice, truth, and dignity of all people. Changing from an ego-centric life to an altruistic life is a possibility for all. This way of life brings us closer to who we are, the image and likeness of our Heavenly Father. It brings joy, fulfilment and peace which is at the bottom of all our longings and hungers. This is the way of the wise.

What are some of my deepest yearnings?

What are some of the ways my ego binds me from being Christ like?

Am I willing to detach myself from false promises of the social media?

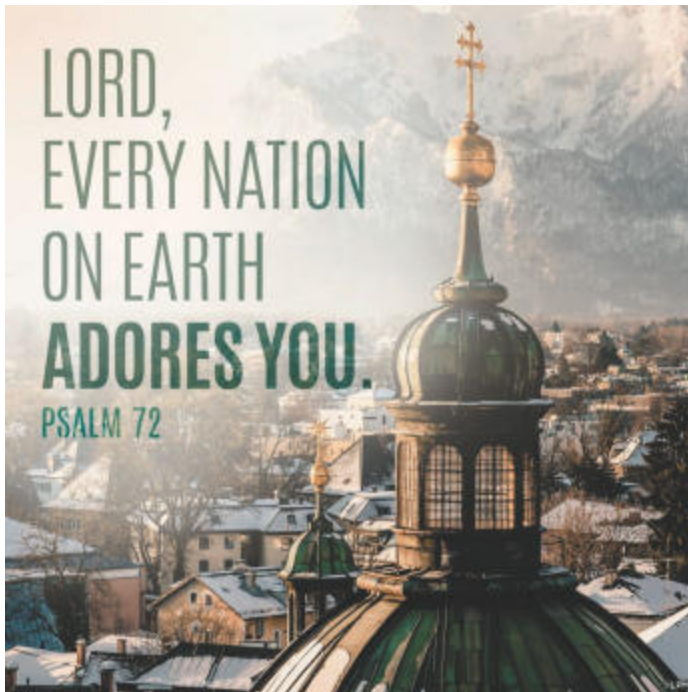
