## Staff Reflection

In today's Gospel we read about the first public miracle of Jesus, which took place at the wedding feast of Cana. As much as the miracle can immediately seize our attention, I am captured by the sense of trust that pervades the story. The more I read the account of this miracle, the more I am drawn to the trust that is so evident in those present.

Mary, when, at the wedding feast the wine runs out, does not hesitate to bring her concerns to Jesus. She, who is always a model of faith, has total trust in her Son, in His mission and in His power. She approaches Jesus and shares with Him the needs of this new bride and groom. She possesses a confidence in Jesus' action, a trust that He will answer her plea. Although she is unaware of how Jesus will answer her plea, she nevertheless shares it with Him, trusting in His Providence. Mary patiently waited, keeping watch of what would happen. She had total trust.

That confidence was more evident when she then tells the servers to "do whatever He tells you." She had no doubt that He heard her and would answer her request.

In our own lives we are invited to that same sense of trust in God's Providence, in His wisdom and in His love for us. Yet often we turn to despair, we become overly anxious, we try to take everything on ourselves. Sometimes our lives are turned in all directions, our world can be shaken and we can feel that God may have forgotten our plea. Today we are reminded to trust in His power, in His blessing and in His promise of being with us always. Like Mary, may we bring our needs before Him and have patient trust.

On retreat this past summer, my director made clear my impatient trust of God and suggested that I trust in the slow work of God. I was directed to pray the following each day. It has been a great source of peace in my life and so I share it with you, hoping it may be a gift for you, as well.

### Patient Trust

Above all, trust in the slow work of God.

We are quite naturally impatient in everything to reach the end without delay.

We should like to skip the intermediate stages.

We are impatient of being on the way to something unknown, something new.

And yet it is the law of all progress that it is made by passing through some stages of instability—and that it may take a very long time.

And so I think it is with you; your ideas mature gradually—let them grow, let them shape themselves, without undue haste.

Don't try to force them on, as though you could be today what time (that is to say, grace and circumstances acting on your own good will) will make of you tomorrow.

Only God could say what this new spirit gradually forming within you will be. Give Our Lord the benefit of believing that his hand is leading you, and accept the anxiety of feeling yourself in suspense and incomplete.

You may have noticed these figures on the widows as you enter the vestibule of the church. A few months ago, there were 227 of these images, representing students and members of our parish needing seats in our new Early Childhood Education Center and Spirituality Center. Today, due to the generosity of many of our parishioners and friends there are only 69 still standing; all these others now have seats.

Three years ago, our goal was to raise \$6 million to ensure the completion of four projects. To date we have \$5.5 million in pledges and gifts. That is an amazing gift for our parish. The hope is that we will reach our goal before the start of Lent, the beginning of March. To reach our goal all are encouraged to participate, every gift moves us one step closer to preparing for the future of St. Patrick Parish.

## IT MAY ONLY BE THE FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD, BUT IT IS NEVER TOO EARLY TO PREPARE FOR LENT.

Although it's only the early days of January and we may have only begun to put away our Christmas decorations, we are encouraged to begin to reflect upon “what will Lent look like for me?” Will it be a time for me to grow in holiness and allow myself to be drawn closer to the Lord? Or will it arrive and be gone so quickly that my life hasn't changed. Lent begins in early March, but our parish is already preparing for opportunities to assist us in deepening our faith. All of the details are still in process, but the list below are invitations for us to be prepared to meet the Lord in a special way when Lent arrives.



**Oremus** – a guide to Catholic Prayer – essentials of an effective and fruitful prayer life. To begin the first week of Lent and go through 1<sup>st</sup> week in Easter (March – April 20<sup>th</sup>)

**Simple Supper** – An evening for married couples, that will include light food, prayer and a guest speaker.

**Lenten Day of Service** – for families to participate in projects in the service of others.

**24 Hours with the Lord** – Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for 24 Hours in the Church.

**Day of Reconciliation** – for 9 hours (from 10AM – 7PM) priests will be available in our church for the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
