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

From the Director:

Discounted ADA ride tickets are available in the main office for only \$2.00 per ride. If you are eligible to take the ADA Paratransit service, you can obtain ride tickets from the Bristol Senior Center office at a reduced rate. Rides can be used to get to Doctor's appointments, grocery stores, or other places outside of Bristol. If you would like information on how to apply for this service, see Lauren in the main office. We also have passes for the city buses available in the main office. If you need transportation and don't have a car, see Lauren in the main office to obtain a Bristol bus pass.

Join us on Friday mornings from 9:00am-12:00pm in the Art room to help us assemble blankets for the homeless out of plastic shopping bags. No special skills are needed, just a desire to help out those less fortunate. We hope to see you there.

AARP will be offering free tax preparation again this year at the Senior Center. Free tax preparation will be done on Tuesdays and Fridays at the Senior Center from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. beginning February 8th. Taxes are done by appointment only. The City will offer the Senior Volunteer Tax Relief Program once again this year. The program was approved at the January 11th City Council meeting making it official. The purpose of the program is to provide a tax credit of \$300 to a person or household that meets the following criteria:

Eligibility Requirements:

Bristol Resident 60 years of age or older Own real property as a principle residence Have an annual income not to exceed \$45,000/single, or \$50,000/couple Must volunteer a minimum of 50 hours at a non-profit agency between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022.

AARP Income Tax Preparation

Every Tuesday and Friday beginning February 8, 2022 to April 12, 2022 8:30am - 12:30pm

The following documents should be brought with you:



- Social Security Cards or SSA1099 forms for everyone involved in the return
- Birth dates for everyone involved in the return
- Wage and earning, pension or other retirement income statements (W-2's, W-2G, 1099-R, or 1099-Misc.)
- Interest and Dividend Statements from Banks (1099-INT and –Div)
- The IRS reporting brokerage statements
- IRS Letter 6475 EIP Payment #3, and IRS Letter 6419 Advance Child Tax Credit if applica-
- A blank check for proof of bank account routing and account numbers for direct deposit
- Total paid for daycare provider and the daycare provider's tax identifying number such as the SS# or business Employer Identification #
- Stimulus Payments 1 & 2 amounts.
- Your Tax Records envelope with this year's and last year's federal and state returns and other tax documents.
- Charitable cash donations, even if not itemizing.
- Unemployment forms 1099-G. These must be printed from your web access prior to appointment.

Also please bring a face mask and a writing utensil. AARP does not want to offer face to face appointments at this time, so people will be asked to sit in the hallway while the taxes are prepared.

Note: We electronically file tax returns and both spouses must sign the required forms on a married-filing-joint return. Get help with your taxes free of charge.

Appointments are required! Please call the office to set up an appointment and arrange to get an Intake Kit.

COVID TESTING CLINIC




