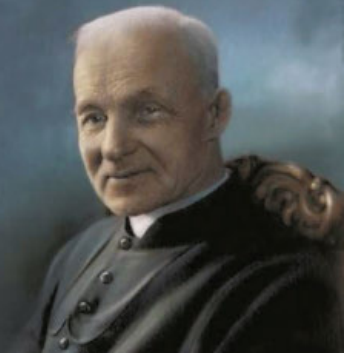

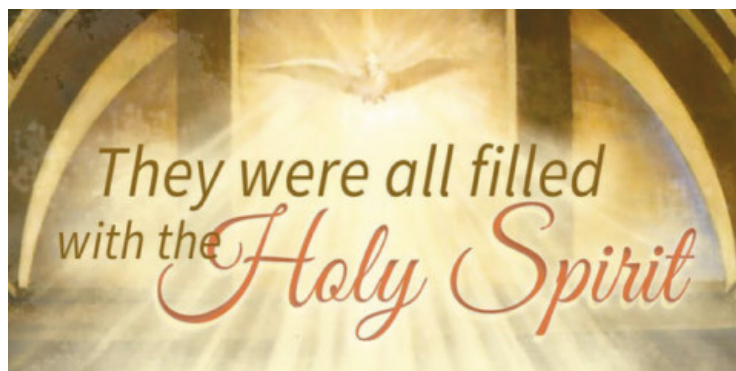

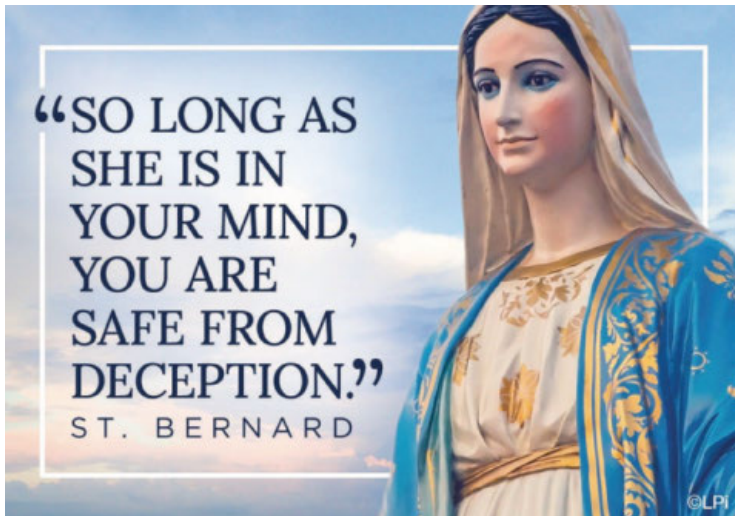

QA **Coming Back to Church**

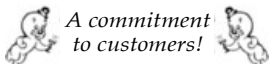

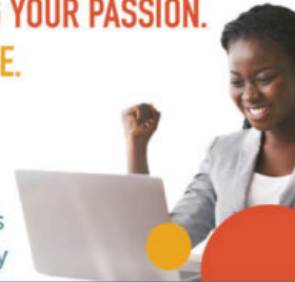
