## PARISH COVID PRECAUTIONS



Our parish is making great efforts to provide a safe environment for those who attend Mass during the pandemic in all of our churches. This includes:

- Each church is equipped with air sanitizing filters which work through the air handlers to eradicate the COVID-19 virus (and other viruses as well.) For further info: <u>https://iwaveair.com/how-it-works/</u>
- Hand sanitizing stations are located at each entrance to the church.
- Handrails and door handles are regularly sanitized.
- Those who distribute Holy Communion are required to wear facemasks.
- Those who serve in the role of greeter at the door are required to wear facemasks.
- Music ministers are required to wear facemasks
- Bishop da Cunha (Diocese of Fall River) has strongly recommended the use of facemasks by all who attend Mass. As a parish, we highly recommend this to our parishioners and guests.
- Those with compromised health conditions or with any symptoms of illness should consider remaining at home.
- Masses are livestreamed from St. Anthony Church for those who are not comfortable attending Mass
- Masses at St. Anthony and St. Elizabeth Seton can also be listened to on your car radio at 87.9FM.
  Communion for listeners will be distributed after Mass at the east door of St. Anthony and the front door of St. Elizabeth Seton.
- Students and volunteers in our youth Faith Formation program are required to wear facemasks at all times during our in-person sessions.

We hope that the above measures will make you feel more comfortable attending Mass. Let us continue to pray for an end to the pandemic. —Fr Steve

#### **CURSILLO RETREAT**



# PARISH BABY NEEDS COLLECTION




