

The Feast of the Holy Family gives us an important reminder, that like every family, the Holy Family faced a full range of life's challenges and difficulties. There's a great temprange of life's challenges and difficulties. There's a great temptation to idealize them, and keep them as plaster figures with halos on a shelf. This family was holy--- but they were also human! They had to live in the same world we do -- with deadlines to meet, bills to pay, meals to prepare and setbacks to overcome. Many times over--their patience and their love were tested. Our 2nd reading from St. Paul's beautiful letter to the Colossians gives us a great teaching on the dynamics of love within a family. He speaks eloquently of love—but not romantic love. Rather, Paul tells us how to form a healthy and holy Christian community in the family. We can draw lessons on how to form a healthy and holy Christian family -- a family like the one in Nazareth. St. Paul tells us: 1) Put on compassion/kindness/lowliness/meekness/patience/forgiveness and love.

2) It is all that simple -- and all that difficult. 3) Yes---the Holy Family most certainly had moments when living those virtues seemed hard, or even impossible! BUT--- they did something we don't always do: They listened to angels. They listened to God. They dreamed. And they let go -- and let God.




