A WORD FROM DEACON STEVE

Our time in Lent is a special time having us to focus anew on the practices of fasting, prayer and almsgiving. It is fitting that we should also have the opportunity to gather our community for our parish mission. I am especially excited because this year our speaker will be Fr. Paschal A. Morlino, OSB. The OSB indicates that he is of the Order of St. Benedict. My deacon formation was administered by the Archabbey of St. Meinrad, a Benedictine monastery in southern Indiana. I have to say that I owe a big portion of my spiritual growth to the monks of St. Meinrad. The Archabbey was built in the late 1800's in southern Indiana. My parish in Indiana conducted Men's retreats at the Archabbey once a year for more than 25 years. I cannot think about the place without a warm remembrance of the interesting, joyfilled and instructional retreats we had. The Archabbey staff also administered our deacon formation which culminated in a weeklong retreat at the Archabbey learning how to give homilies. From looking over his biography, Fr. Morlino does not have a direct connection with St. Meinrad, but has been associated with several Abbeys over the long course of his varied ministerial career. He has been at St. Benedict Parish in Baltimore since 1984. I will not try to describe his vast and interesting experiences. But let me say that our parish mission is a time to reflect on our faith and a time to join with our fellow parishioners in asking where is God in our lives and how can I better serve him? This is a time to have our faith touched and renewed. We have come through a terrifically difficult year. We are all worn down and exhausted by the challenges we have endured. Can you let God give you a gift of time and renewal? Come and join with us as we allow Fr. Morlino to help us rejuvenate our spirits. The Mission is March 15th, 16th, and 17th at 7 PM.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Awake, O Sleeper!

This morning came a little earlier than I would have liked — Daylight Savings Time always does. Sometimes that morning sunlight seems more intrusive than illuminating. You're still half-lost in sleep, and that sun is demanding of you a lot more than you're ready to give.

I've said it, and I'm sure you've said it, too. "Just five more minutes." You hit the "snooze" button on your iPhone once (maybe twice? Show of hands?) and turn away from the window. So many kings of the Old Testament were steadfast in their sleepy ways, rejecting the light their God tried to share with them. Likewise, John tells us that, though Light — Christ — was sent into the world, the world preferred darkness.

Sometimes it seems, when reading through Scripture, that all throughout salvation history, God has been trying to pull back the curtains, to rouse us from our defiant slumber. And we resist Him. Time and time again, we resist Him.

Light brings a certain responsibility with it. It seems to compel productivity. Furthermore, there's no hiding in the light. Any photographer worth his salt knows how to manipulate it, highlighting the good and casting some merciful shade on the bad.

As we enter into the fourth week of Lent, we're getting so close to the main event. Can we handle the light that will come on Easter morning, bursting into the tomb as the stone is rolled away? Can we keep ourselves from hitting the "snooze" button on our souls, and sit up to face the dawn of a new day?



Year of ST. JOSEPH



How can I receive a plenary indulgence during the year of St. Joseph?

The plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions:

1. Go to confession
2. Receive Eucharistic Communion
3. Pray for the intentions of the holy family
4. Choose from the following during the year of St. Joseph:
 - Participate in a spiritual retreat for at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph.
 - Pray for St. Joseph's intercession for the unemployed that they might find dignifying work.
 - Recite the Litany of St. Joseph
 - Entrust one's daily work and activity to the protection of St. Joseph the Worker.
 - Follow St. Joseph's example in performing a corporal work of mercy.
 - Perform one of the spiritual works of mercy
 - Pray the rosary together with one's family
 - Engaged couples can also receive an indulgence from praying the rosary together.
 - Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer,
 - Celebrate the feast of St. Joseph on March 19 with an act of piety in honor of St. Joseph.
 - Pray an approved prayer to St. Joseph on the 19th of any month.
 - Honor Joseph with an act of piety or approved prayer on a Wednesday, the day traditionally dedicated to St. Joseph.
 - Celebrate the feast of St. Joseph the Worker on May 1 with an act of piety or prayer.

THE YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH PRAYER

To you, O blessed Joseph, do we come in our afflictions, and having implored the help of your most holy Spouse, we confidently invoke your patronage also.

Through that charity which bound you to the Immaculate Virgin Mother of God and through the paternal love with which you embraced the Child Jesus, we humbly beg you graciously to regard the inheritance which Jesus Christ has purchased by his Blood, and with your power and strength to aid us in our necessities.

O most watchful guardian of the Holy Family, defend the chosen children of Jesus Christ; O most loving father, ward off from us every contagion of error and corrupting influence; O our most mighty protector, be kind to us and from heaven assist us in our struggle with the power of darkness.

As once you rescued the Child Jesus from deadly peril, so now protect God's Holy Church from the snares of the enemy and from all adversity; shield, too, each one of us by your constant protection, so that, supported by your example and your aid, we may be able to live piously, to die in holiness, and to obtain eternal happiness in heaven. Amen.


