Holy Thursday – Mass of the Lord’s Supper
April 2nd, 2026 at 7:00 PM

The washing of the feet ritual that takes place on Holy Thursday is often referred to as the *Mandatum*, from Jesus’ words at the Last Supper (Jn 13:14) “*Mandatum novum do vobis...*” - I give you a new commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you, says the Lord.

It is a rite that is meant to signify, in a powerful way, the love we are all called to have for one another, as exemplified in Jesus’ actions at the last supper when he washed his disciples’ feet. For many years the Roman Missal rubric called for *12* *servi* (slaves), the chosen men, but Pope Francis, in 2016, decreed that the select should be chosen from among all members of the People of God: men and women, young and old, healthy and sick, clergy, religious and laity to encourage broad, conscious, active and fruitful participation in the ritual.

Will you please join us on Holy Thursday at the Mass of the Lord’s Supper and have one foot washed as part of this special ritual?

From the Pastor's Desk Palm Sunday

Today, with Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, we embark on the **HOLIEST** of weeks, the first and most important in our liturgical year. Each day provides a renewed opportunity to celebrate the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion: This year we walk with the Lord during His final days, proclaiming the Passion according to Luke. Each of the Passion narratives has a different feel to it, as the evangelist emphasizes some subtle themes. Walk with Jesus in His triumphal entry into Jerusalem as the adoring crowd's wave palm branches and shout "Hosanna."

Holy Thursday: This is the commemoration of the Last Supper, as the Lord instituted the Eucharist and the Priesthood. We hear from John's Gospel of the *mandatum*, the Lord's command to "wash the feet" of the other, to "do this in memory of me." Come along and celebrate with us; the **Mass of the Lord's Supper will begin at 7:00 PM** and will include the Eucharistic procession and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Also, sacred oils will be presented for use in our parish throughout the year.

Good Friday: John's Passion narrative dominates this celebration, as we venerate the Cross and receive Holy Communion. This has been the only day of the year when Mass is not celebrated. The altar is stripped down to emphasize that the Lord has died and entered the tomb. **Please join us at 3:00 PM. Also, there will be Stations of the Cross at Noon.**

The Great Vigil of Easter: Holy Saturday brings the marvelous celebration of the Lord's Resurrection. The blessing of the Paschal Candle, the singing of the Exsultet, the proclamation of salvation history in Sacred Scripture, and the celebration of the Most Holy Eucharist mark this great day. **Please join us at 7:30 PM.**

EASTER SUNDAY: We will celebrate the Lord's Resurrection with **Mass at 8 AM, 9:30 AM, and 11 AM.**
