THE SACRAMENTS

Parents are **required** to attend a preparation session concerning the Sacrament of Baptism. Baptism Preparation Sessions are held on the <u>second</u> Monday of every month from 7:00-8:00 p.m. Baptisms are on the <u>first</u> Sunday of the month at 1:00 PM at *Mary Mother of Peace.* Baptisms on the third Sunday of the month during the 11:00 AM Mass are suspended until further notice. In order for your child/children to be baptized, you must be registered parishioners of the parish.

Basic Guidelines and Information to be Qualified as a Godparent/Godparents: A person may only have one or two godparents (also called sponsors); if two are chosen, they must be male and female. In order for someone to be eligible as a godparent they must be chosen by the parents, have the ability and the intention to fulfill the role, be at least 16 years of age, be a baptized Roman Catholic, be a confirmed Roman Catholic, received the Most Holy Eucharist, and be in good standing which is leading a life in harmony with the Catholic Faith (including Marriage) and will be a good role model for the one being baptized, and be neither the father nor the mother of the child (Code of Canon Law, cc. #867-868; Catechism of the Catholic Church #1251).

A baptized person who belongs to another Christian community may be admitted only as a "Christian witness" (not a godparent) provided that there is at least one Roman Catholic godparent who fulfills the above criteria. A non-baptized person cannot be a witness (Code of Canon Law, cc. #872-874; Catechism of the Catholic Church #1255).

MARRIAGE

Diocesan policy requires a year of preparation. Please contact the Pastor at least one year prior to the wedding to begin preparation.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Parishioners facing surgery or struggling with serious illness may request the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

This process welcomes any **unbaptized person** who is seeking to become a member of the Catholic Church; to any person baptized in another Christian Church who is considering the possibility of becoming a member of the Catholic Church. Please contact the parish Office for more info.

USCCB President and Committee Chairman Call for Prayers, Hope, and Assistance Following Deadly Tornadoes in the South and Midwest



WASHINGTON - Archbishop José H. Gomez of Los Angeles, president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, and Archbishop Paul S. Coakley of Oklahoma City, chairman of the Committee on Domestic Justice and Human Development, have issued the following statement after tornadoes tore through multiple states in the South and Midwest late Friday into early Saturday morning.

In their statement, Archbishops Gomez and Coakley call for prayer and assistance for all those who were in the path of the storm:

"It is heartbreaking to see the destruction and devastation brought by the tornadoes that tore through the South and Midwest overnight. During this Advent season where we await in joyful anticipation for the birth of our Lord, we pray for those who have been injured, for those who have lost their lives, and for their grieving families and communities. May those who have been impacted by these storms find peace, comfort, and hope in our faith and in God's endless love. We also pray for the emergency responders and those who have begun the work of providing for the needs of the impacted in these communities in the recovery efforts. We entrust all our brothers and sisters in harm's way to our Blessed Mother, and we ask for her continued protection and for her intercession in comforting those who are suffering.


