THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Parents are **required** to attend a preparation session concerning the Sacrament of Baptism. Baptism Preparation Sessions are held on the second Monday of every month from 7:00-8:00 p.m. Baptisms are on the first Sunday of the month at 1:00 PM at *Mary Mother of Peace*. Baptisms on the third Sunday of the month during the 11:00 AM Mass are suspended until further notice.

In order for your child/children to be baptized, you must be registered parishioners of the parish.

Basic Guidelines and Information to be Qualified as a Godparent/Godparents: A person may only have one or two godparents (also called sponsors); if two are chosen, they must be male and female. In order for someone to be eligible as a godparent they must be chosen by the parents, have the ability and the intention to fulfill the role, be at least 16 years of age, be a baptized Roman Catholic, be a confirmed Roman Catholic, received the Most Holy Eucharist, and be in good standing which is leading a life in harmony with the Catholic Faith (including Marriage) and will be a good role model for the one being baptized, and be neither the father nor the mother of the child (Code of Canon Law, cc. #867-868; Catechism of the Catholic Church #1251).

A baptized person who belongs to another Christian community may be admitted only as a "Christian witness" (not a godparent) provided that there is at least one Roman Catholic godparent who fulfills the above criteria. A non-baptized person cannot be a witness (Code of Canon Law, cc. #872-874; Catechism of the Catholic Church #1255).

MARRIAGE

Diocesan policy requires a year of preparation. Please contact the Pastor at least one year prior to the wedding to begin preparation.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Parishioners facing surgery or struggling with serious illness may request the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

This process welcomes any **unbaptized person** who is seeking to become a member of the Catholic Church; **to any person baptized in another Christian Church** who is considering the possibility of becoming a member of the Catholic Church. *Please contact the parish Office for more info.*

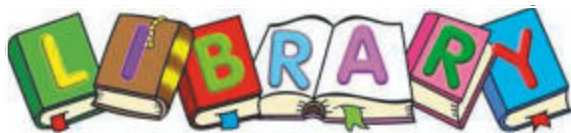

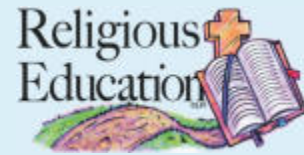

Encouraging News for Pro-Life Supporters:

Today was a very encouraging day in Seaford, site of Planned Parenthood's newest location in Sussex County. I was attending a prayer vigil/protest this morning with my brother when I was pleasantly surprised. In the first hour, a truck pulled up at the intersection and asked me to come over. The driver said he was "very supportive of what we were doing" and wanted to become involved with our movement. He mentioned that he works in a business with his son, who he and his wife adopted from a young woman who was raped, but chose life for her son. I took his business card and said I would be in contact with him. Another driver stopped at the same time and told my brother of his strong support for us.

In the second hour, a woman stopped her van at our location and came over to me stating, "I wholeheartedly support what you are doing. I am the mother of six, and when I rode by and saw you here, I had to do something to thank you." She then handed me two gift certificates to Dunkin' Donuts for my brother and me.

*I hope many others will be encouraged by our fantastic day and come and join us in the near future. The Planned Parenthood office saw little activity, but, unfortunately, they can do abortions with the abortion pill on-line which does not, according to Delaware law, require the pregnant moms to come to the office in person or see a doctor. **We must continue to have a strong presence there in Seaford to inform the public and would be moms of the dangers this facility can bring to the health and welfare of Seaford.***

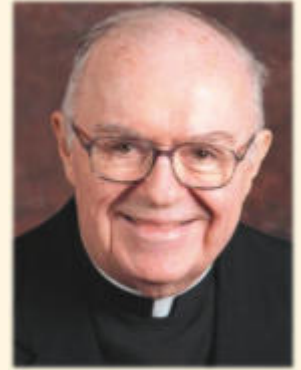

Father Robert G. Reece, Oblate of St. Francis de Sales for 66 years, dies at 86



CHILDS, Md. — Father Robert G. Reece, a professed member of the Oblate of St. Francis de Sales for 66 years, died Dec. 6. He was 86.

Father Reece was a Philadelphia native who entered the Oblates upon his graduation from Northeast Catholic High School. He was ordained in 1965 and ministered as a teacher at two Oblate high schools. After leaving education, he served as the chaplain of the Bernardine Franciscans in Reading, Pa., and had lived at the Oblate residence in Wyndmoor, Pa., from 2009-20. He retired to Childs in April 2020.

Father Reece was predeceased by his twin brother, Oblate Father Richard T. Reece, who died last February. He is survived by an older brother, Edward J., and a cousin, Mary Doyle, as well as many nieces and nephews.

Mass of Christian Burial was said Dec. 14, with interment at the Oblate Cemetery. Donations in Father Reece's name can be made to the Oblate Development Fund, P.O. Box 87, Childs, MD 21916-0087.
