

### What Confession Is—and What It's Not


Confession (also known as the Sacrament of Reconciliation) is one of the most beautiful and powerful encounters with God's mercy. In this sacrament, we receive absolution for our sins, are restored to grace, and are strengthened to live a holier life. It is where we say, "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned," and God responds, "I absolve you..."

However, from time to time, we need a gentle reminder of what Confession is not. It is not a counseling session. It is not the place for extended storytelling, background history, or processing our feelings. The priest is there in the person of Christ to hear your sins, not your entire life story.

The Church teaches that we should confess mortal sins in kind and number, and it is also good to confess venial sins. A good confession is brief, clear, and sincere. If deeper issues or emotional burdens need unpacking, your parish priest is always happy to set up a separate time for spiritual direction or pastoral counseling.

Remember: many others may be waiting in line. Please be respectful of their time and the nature of the sacrament. If it helps, prepare your confession beforehand by examining your conscience and writing down your sins. God already knows the details—He's just waiting for you to bring them to Him with a contrite heart.







#### SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION:

Information about all sacraments, as well as Godparent & Sponsor requirements, can be found on our website or by calling the Parish Office.

The **Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick** is available **when someone is facing surgery or serious illness**. Call the Parish Office during regular business hours to arrange. **In an emergency**, please call the Parish Office to request a priest to visit. [After regular Office Hours, call 589-0824.] \*\* Parishioners who are homebound due to age or illness, and are unable to attend Mass, can contact the Parish Office to make arrangements to receive Holy Communion.

The **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)** is a process for adults interested in becoming Catholic, as well as adults who would like to complete the Sacraments of Initiation.

#### ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION:

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

An Act of "Spiritual Communion," where we unite ourselves to God through prayer, is a beautiful way to express to God our desire to be united with Him when we are unable to complete that union in the reception of Holy Communion—either because we are not physically present at Mass, or we are not in a state of grace and need to receive the Sacrament of Penance first, or we have not observed the mandatory Eucharistic fast of 1 hour before communion.

**Why register in a parish?**

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission.
