





PRAY FOR UKRAINE



Begin by calming yourself, focusing on your breathing, and becoming aware of the life force that flows through your veins. Center yourself in the words and affections

of St. Augustine's Prayer to the Holy Spirit: "Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit, That my thoughts may all be holy. Act in me, O Holy Spirit, That my work, too, may be holy. Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit, That I love but what is holy. Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit, To defend all that is holy." Sanctifying, bringing things to wholeness, blessing, restoring, and creating are just some fruits of the presence of the Holy Spirit. Being filled with the Holy Spirit is not always about proclaiming loud cries of praise or singing alleluia from a rooftop. It is about unfolding and encountering the ordinary in an extraordinary way. Being filled with the Holy Spirit means being filled with the fullness of God's life and in touch with the power and wonder of God's presence. It is about becoming holy.

It is not just for saints or people with a religious vocation. Holiness is for the ordinary, simple, run-of-the-mill person who desires to love God, others, and all of creation. When an ordinary, humble person becomes connected with life and the wondrous power of God's love, they begin to live more deeply and reverently, desire a simple fare, and rel-

ish in ordinary beauty. Their senses become attuned to the Author of life, and they realize they are not alone. The Holy Spirit connects all the dots of human experience and existence, bringing everyone to center on the Divine Presence. The Holy Spirit does not just breathe "on me" but "in me" and is the force behind every breath I take. Take a moment to soak that thought in. Right now, there is the Divine Presence of the Holy Spirit in me. When people become in touch with truth, they know that when inspired by the Holy Spirit, their actions are not solely their own. They realize they are moved by Divine Grace and drawn to things not found in secular affairs.

We live in a world where it is hard to discover truth. So many imposters veil the truth that it is hard to find, especially for those who are young. It is easy to get fooled and duped, and often, without full conscious awareness of doing so, we choose to walk down a path of selfabsorption and destruction. Only the Holy Spirit, through the church's ministry, guides us to truth and shows us how to be the graced and holy human beings God made us to be. The wonders and inspirations of today's Feast of Pentecost are necessary to share with those we love and those who only casually cross our paths. The first disciples, touched by the Holy Spirit, brought the Gospel to the ends of the earth one step at a time. Is it unrealistic to ask that we assist in that same mission by helping people understand who they are and who God is one at a time? Ask the Holy Spirit to alleviate the fear in your heart that prevents you from doing so.

This Day in History — May 20, 1851

Emile Berliner Born May 20, 1851 d. 1929

German-born American inventor patented the first flat disc record player (1887, gramophone). Earlier recording devices by Thomas Edison and Alexander Graham Bell used difficult-to-mass-produce cylinders. His device was known as a "gramophone."



Artist Francis Barraud (1856-1924) painted his brother's dog, *Nipper* listening to the horn of an early phonograph. Victor Talking Machine Company began using the symbol in their trademark.

https://en.wikipedia.org org/wiki/Victor_Talking Machine Company As the popularity of the gramophone began to pick up, Berliner found himself dealing with infringers on his patents. In June 1900, the court granted an injunction against Berliner and the United States Gramophone Company, which compelled Emile Berliner's exit from the gramophone business in America.

Berliner transferred his patents to Eldridge Johnson, but Berliner retained a share in the new company. In March 1901, Johnson registered the name Victor Talking Machine Co. and launched the brand later in the year. By 1905, it had regained the lead in the American disc record business.
