



hurt, or prolonged suffering. It's no wonder euthanasia is rapidly becoming acceptable around the world. Through purely human eyes, there is no issue bypassing the inevitable, taking control, and bringing things more swiftly to a place of peace.

If this is how God sees things, then why does Jesus make such a big deal in helping us understand and embrace the experience of suffering? God's wisdom takes us in another direction. Imagine if we were able to eradicate ALL hardship and suffering. Where would we be? Many solid, more growth-producing life lessons have been born of suffering, disappointment, inconvenience, darkness, and despair. There is something sacred about these experiences as God uses them to create something new.

Envisioning life without hardship and suffering brings us to a vision where everything is flat-lined and dull. As much as hardship and suffering are difficult crosses to bear, not taking them up runs the risk of us becoming shallow, empty, and lifeless. Helen Keller remarks, "A happy life consists not in the absence but in the mastery of hardships." What a sage insight! Many successful people and saints were brought to their station in life because they suffered. Suffering teaches us what's essential and propels us to search the depths of our souls for resources and strength we would never have known before.

This is especially true when we love as Jesus asks us to love. Above any other experience, love can cause us great hardship, pain, and suffering, especially when it's authentic and unconditional. While it can thrust us into an incredible experience of God and life, on the one hand, it can bruise and wound us deeply on the other. Mastering the art of love is the secret to living well, walking in the presence of God, and investing in the joy of the Gospel. Love and suffering walk hand-in-hand. Com- promising one will compromise the other. That may be why Jesus spent so much time convincing us to accept both.

#### This Day in History: May 20, 1950

**Armed Forces Day** is celebrated on the third Saturday in May, this year May 17, 2023. It falls near the end of Armed Forces Week, which begins on the second Saturday of May and ends on the third Sunday of May.

First observed on May 20, 1950, the day was created on Aug. 31,1949 to honor Americans serving in the five U.S. military branches – the U.S. Army, U.S. Navy, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Air Force and U.S. Coast Guard – following the consolidation of the military services in the U.S. Department of Defense. It was intended to replace the separate Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps and Coast Guard Days, but the separate days are still observed, especially within the respective services.

The first Armed Forces Day was celebrated by parades, open houses, receptions and air shows. The United States' longest continuously running Armed Forces Day Parade is held in Bremerton, Washington. In 2019, Bremerton celebrated the 71st Armed Forces Day Parade.
