





Many people seek tangible forms of security that will safeguard their livelihood and prepare them for the future. We tend to associate

safety and security with things: the accumulation of goods and possessions, retirement funds, savings accounts, and substantial incomes. While acquiring these promises, a life with less anxiety and worry, we find ourselves more preoccupied and consumed with their growth and preservation. We worry more! We can quickly become quasi-hoarders, consumed by the desire to obtain more tangible crutches. Our minds and hearts are always restless, and we never seem at peace.

Why do we so easily give our self-worth, value, and sense of security over to things? God certainly does not deny us t

the pursuit of a productive and enjoyable life, but where do we draw the line? A sense of well-being and happiness can easily get deferred to sometime "in the future" while we continue to wrestle with the toils of today. There is no guarantee that there will be an earthly tomorrow, and all the frenzy we bring to securing our state in life will be for naught. When we are called from this world, will we even know where to begin to look for the tranquility and repose our souls so desperately need?

We cannot be hoarders, pursuers of vanity, or greedy. They don't work, as they are too dependent on things that can fall apart. Rather than constantly feeling the need for more, we must learn to be grateful for what we have. By looking inward, we can learn how to live lives of faithful service to others. This Day in History — August 3, 1977



The TRS-80 Micro Computer System is a desktop microcomputer launched in 1977 and sold by Tandy Corporation through their Radio Shack stores. The name is an abbreviation of Tandy Radio Shack, Z80 [microprocessor]. It is one of the earliest mass-produced and mass-marketed retail home computers.

Tandy was one of three companies (along with Commodore International and Apple) that started the personal computer revolution by introducing complete pre-assembled microcomputers instead of a kit. Their TRS-80 line of home computers were popular in the years before the IBM PC became commonplace, and had wide distribution in Radio Shack stores at a time when there were few computer stores.


