



Hello, and happy 15th Sunday of Ordinary Time! I hope you are doing well in these summer days. It's been a little warm out there, to be sure. Recently someone asked me if they have similar weather in Indiana, and for the most part, yes they do! South Bend is just a little east of Lake Michigan, so we get quite a bit of "lake effect" weather – snow in the winter and humidity in the summer. But it's still a great place to live, and there's no better sweet corn, I assure you!

Why do I mention Indiana? Well, next weekend (July 17-21) Indianapolis will host the 10th National Eucharistic Congress. This will be an amazing gathering of Catholics from around the country, listening to amazing speakers, praying together and adoring the Blessed Sacrament. It is "an invitation to experience profound personal revival so we can be sent out to share Christ's love with a world that so desperately needs it." This September our diocese will have the opportunity to have a diocesan Eucharistic conference at **Bishop Connolly High School in Fall River, on Saturday, September 7th**. More details to come, but you might want to "save the date" for an opportunity to come together as a diocese in prayer and worship as Catholics of the local Church.

As you may know, there have been a couple of polls out recently asking people if they believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The pollsters are asking different categories of people, including "baptized, active Catholics". The problem is how one defines "active". That definition seems to have changed over the years – I say "seems to" because it really hasn't. To be an active Catholic means participating regularly in Sunday Mass, doing our very best to live the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and availing ourselves of the Sacraments as needed (especially Confession!). Depending on which poll you read, the percentage of folks who believe in the Real Presence varies widely...

It isn't really possible to force someone to have faith, right? They need to be exposed to the faith on a regular basis, in fact to be imbued with the faith. For someone to find God in a vacuum isn't impossible (for nothing is impossible for God!), but how much easier it is to know, love and serve God when you have experienced Him in your upbringing and everyday life. That's why Holy Cross priest Fr. Patrick Peyton's saying on prayer is so important: "**The family that prays together, stays together.**" When we are visible in practicing our faith amidst our loved ones and friends, it can't help but draw them into closer relationship with the Lord.

May God bless our parish family this week – let us pray for one another!
