

March 13, 2022 2ND SUNDAY OF LENT

Dear Parishioners,

Just a few points to share with everyone as a result of Finance and Parish Councils meetings that took place on February 7, 2022

Finance Council:

Agreed to renovation of some rooms at the rectory on the first floor Agreed to sale or lease the convent building - We are exploring some options at this point.

Proceed with upgrading or changing the sound system in the Church Future Renovation of the Chapel - More TBD

Most important decision made is that we agreed that we need to start a new chapter by paying off all debts we have, but paying all outstanding bills - Already happened. Paying current bills on time and paying off the diocese after some reasonable forgiveness: Debt to the Diocese for Fiscal Years 2012 - 2021 is \$26,418.33 and to bring Fiscal Year 2022 up to date of \$12,389.77 Brings total due of \$38,808.10.

In the past money was deposit in savings account by bills were not paid. We can't follow that way anymore. Due debt will be withdraw from our savings account in the diocese.

Parish Council:

Parish Council approved Schedule for Lent and Easter.

Suggestion was made to send survey to all parents that they have children in our faith formation program with a few questions - We did that last week.

To have a Youth Mass with youth music.

Agreed to improvement of the music by choosing temporary better missals and have to evaluate in the future. Recently we purchased Heritage missals.

We are in the process of getting quotes for improvement of the Heat and AC systems at the cafeteria and kitchen area. At this time prices are very high.

After AC/Heat upgrades are completed, we will proceed with refreshing of the cafeteria.

We are looking to possible use of the school building. We can't afford cost of the heat.

Finally after discussion, we agreed with the suggestion made in the parish surveys that I should dissolved both councils due to many factors with major one being that some members are serving more

Correct time is two terms for 3 years, one year break with possible reelection for another 3 years which brings to 9 years total.

I will have one more meeting with current councils which is scheduled for May 9.

In May we will have nomination forms available in the Church and on website and Facebook.

After nomination is completed, we will have an election in June and new councils will serve starting July 1.

Pare punktów do podzielenia się z wami jako rezultat posiedzeń Rady Finansowej i Parafialnej, które odbyły się 7 lutego 2022 r.

Rada Finansowa:

Zgoda na remont niektórych pomieszczeń na plebanii na pierwszym piętrze Zgoda na sprzedaż lub wydzierżawienie budynku konwentu - rozważamy

Naprawa lub zmiana systemu nagłośnienia w Kościele.

Przyszły remont kaplicy - Więcej do omówienia w przyszłości. Najważniejszą podjętą decyzją dotyczy, że zgodziliśmy się, aby rozpocząć nowy rozdział parafii od spłacenia wszystkich długów, w tym spłacenia wszystkich zaległych rachunków - Na dzień dzisiejszy zaległe rachunki spłacono. Płacenie bieżących rachunków na czas i spłacanie diecezji po rozsądnym przebaczeniu części długu:

Zadłużenie wobec diecezji za lata podatkowe 2012 - 2021 wynosi \$26 418.33 USD, a zaległości za rok podatkowy 2022 sa w wysokości \$12 389,77 USD co daje łączną należność w wysokości \$38,808.10 USD

W przeszłości pieniądze były wpłacane na konto oszczędnościowe a niektóre rachunki nie były opłacane. Nie możemy podążać ta zła drogom. Należny dług zostanie spłacony przy użyciu naszego konta oszczędnościowego w diecezji.

Rada Parafialna:

Rada Parafialna zatwierdziła Harmonogram Wielkiego Postu i Wielkanocy Zaproponowano wysłanie ankiety do wszystkich rodziców którzy mają dzieci w naszym programie formacji wiary, z kilkoma pytaniami - Zrobiliśmy to w zeszłym tygodniu.

Sugestia wprowadzenia Mszy dla młodzieży z muzyką młodzieżowa Potrzeba ulepszenie muzyki - Niedawno zakupiliśmy mszaliki Heritage po Angielsku

Jesteśmy w trakcie uzyskiwania wyceny na ulepszenie systemów ogrzewania i klimatyzacji w kafeterii i kuchni. W tej chwili ceny są bardzo wysokie. Po zakończeniu modernizacji klimatyzacji/ogrzewania przystapimy do remontu kafeterii

Rozglądamy sie za możliwością lepszego wykorzystania budynku szkoły. Nie stać nas na koszt opłaty ogrzewania.

Ostatecznie, po dyskusji, zgodziliśmy się z sugestią wyrażoną w ankietach parafialnych, że powinienem rozwiązać obie rady z powodu wielu czynników, z których głównym jest to, że niektórzy członkowie służą dłużej

Prawidłowy czas to dwie kadencje na 3 lata, roczna przerwa z możliwościa reelekcji na kolejne 3 lata, co daje w sumie 9 lat.

Będę miał jeszcze jedno spotkanie z obecnymi radami, które zaplanowane jest na 9 maja.

W maju będziemy mieć formularze nominacyjne dostępne w Kościele oraz na stronie internetowej i Facebooku.

Po zakończeniu nominacji w czerwcu odbędą się wybory, a nowe rady będą funkcjonować od 1 lipca.


