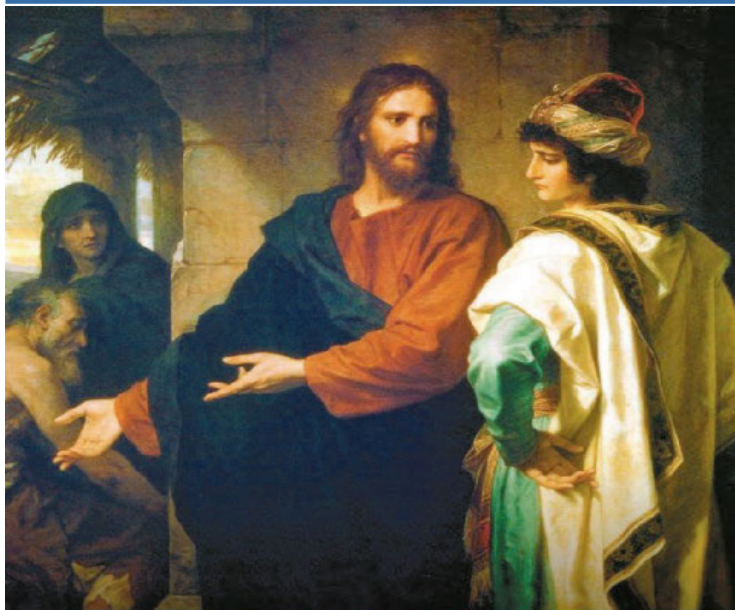

Dear Clergy and Staff,

We are St. Mary Recycle Mission Group and we have been working with Catholic churches, Convents, Schools, The Knights of Columbus, and other organizations, as well as with Parishioners who have things at home in helping rescue and recycle used Religious items that are no longer needed. We originally got started after finding several items cleared out from a church basement in the dumpster of a local church all in perfectly usable condition. We later found that there is a need for these unwanted items. Our first large effort was following Hurricane Katrina in New Orleans as we sent hundreds of recycled items to a parish there that was more than happy to accept items for both the parish and parishioners that we had gathered.

We can take in just about anything of Religious nature that can be used by other churches, convents or religious organizations such as:

- Vestments including Chasubles, Stoles, Albs, etc.
 - Crucifixes
 - Statues (any size, **no outdoor concrete statues**)
 - Rosaries (damaged ok)
 - Altar Books/Missals/Lectionaries
 - Holy Medals
 - Holy Cards
 - Framed Religious Pictures
 - Prayer books//Breviaries/Catholic Encyclopedias
- (Please No Religious Books/Reading Books/Story Books, Hymnals, Pamphlets/Magazines/DVD's, VHS Tapes, Christmas items or Wax Candles)**

We will be in our area for pick ups the weeks of October 14th. Please consider cleaning out the closet and placing us in your bulletin for parishioners to bring in religious items from their home to recycle.

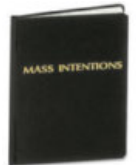
