



Our 90th Christmas-Message from Father C.J.

Merry Christmas to one and all!

hope your family is having a delightful Christmas celebration. As a parish family, we gather together once again and this time we mark the 90th Christmas liturgy celebrated within the walls of this church building. (Reminder...the

First Mass was held December 24, 1931.) We welcome Bishop Byrne who will offer the 10:30 am Christmas Day Mass and we pray the liturgies are very well attended by parishioners and friends of the parish. We once again will be treated to awesome Christmas music by our Music Director and the St. Mary's Adult Choir, as well as by cantors and soloists. How joyful to welcome home college students and visitors from around the country and the world to our magnificent church.

On Sunday, the Feast of The Holy Family, we begin the beautiful church Season of Christmas which runs until Sunday, January 9th. As the song goes, "it's the most wonderful time of the year" and for me, this Season of Christmas is my favorite time of the year to savor the decorations here in our church and visit parishioners in their homes and relax now that the rush is over.

As I type out these words for this article, I am sitting in my office here in Longmeadow. I just drove back from helping out my friend and brother, Fr. Wayne at St. Michael's in East Longmeadow by celebrating their 9 am daily Mass. As I drove along in my comfortable modern vehicle (listening to holiday songs on the radio), I was thinking about the fact that in the early 1900's the priests from St. Michael's would hitch up their horse and buggy (or in the winter horse and sleigh!) and make the trip over here to Longmeadow for the celebration of Sunday Mass. You see, our parish did not become Temporary Church 1927-1931 an official parish until 1936. Up until then, we relied on St. Michael's Parish to provide us with priest coverage. These dedicated priests celebrated Mass in all three St. Mary churches featured to the right until we were created as a parish on our own in 1936. How blessed we have been for all these years and as we begin another Christmas Season here in Longmeadow, I invite you to sit back, savor the beauty of this church dedicated to Our Blessed Mother. Soak in all the music and prayers and the sights and sounds of Christmas and give thanks to Almighty God for our past as well as our future. This weekend, we honor The Holy Family of St. Joseph, Our Blessed Mother and the Christ Child. We hold them up as a beautiful model of tranquility and peace. Once again, Merry Christmas. -Father C.J.

As we celebrate our 90th Christmas in our parish church, we extend a very special welcome to all joining us for our Christmas Masses this year.

The Infant of Prague

During the Christmas season we honor Christ as an infant. As you leave Saint Mary's by the side door, you will pass a small statue, the Infant of Prague, honored all over the Catholic world, especially in Ireland, Italy, the Philippines, and of course, the Czech republic.

Princess Polyxena of Bohemia received the statue as a wedding gift; it had been obtained by her mother when she had visited Spain. The statue was about eighteen inches high and dressed in royal robes and wearing a crown. The Carmelite monastery in Prague had fallen on hard times and the monks were facing having to leave the monastery. The Princess, who was now a widow, gave the statue to the monks in 1628, telling them "I give you what is most precious to me; honor and respect the child Jesus and you shall never be Carmelite sister named in want." Sure enough, the princess' words came true -- for a while. Then because of war the Carmelites had to flee the city, and in their haste the statue fell into the hands of the invaders and was thrown into a rubbish heap by the protestant invaders. In 1635 Father Cyril, one of the monks, returned to Prague to find the statue, and having found it, placed it back in the refurbished chapel. As he was kneeling in prayer, he heard these words: "Have mercy on me and I will have mercy on you. Give me hands and I will give you peace. The more you honor me, the more I will bless you." Father Cyril moved the cape covering the child and saw that the hands were broken off. Father Cyril prayed that he would find a way to restore the hands, and heard the infant tell him to place the statue near the entrance to the monastery. A passing craftsman offered to repair it, and when completed, the statue's right hand was raised in blessing, two fingers extended (to signify the two natures of Christ) and the thumb and three fingers touching (to signify the three Persons in one God). The left hand holds a globe with a cross on it, signifying that Christ is king of all creation.

The intercession of the Infant Jesus, sought by praying before the statue, resulted in innumerable miracles and favors, so that the devotion spread throughout the world. Replicas of the statue are everywhere, and some people make it a point to dress the statue in the liturgical colors of the season. A Margarite in 1648 designed a chaplet (like a rosary) and the pray-



ers that go with it, still recited by those who practice the devotion. There is a novena to the Infant that consists of prayers said in each of nine hours (all in one day). The statue is carried in procession on January 14, which is celebrated as the feast of the Infant in some countries.

Saint Therese of Lisieux was a devotee of the Infant and attributed her ability to control her temper (which had been a lifelong problem) to His intercession. Saint Theresa of Avilla was also devoted to the Infant Jesus, and during her lifetime many statues of the Christ child were fashioned. It may be that one of these was brought from Spain to Prague, connecting the two saints.

Two interesting customs: In Ireland, if you want decent weather for your wedding, you should place the statue outside. And if you want him to manage your finances, place a coin or bill at his feet.
