

Dear Friends in Christ,

As Summer approaches, I know that many of you are excited to travel and to spend some vacation time with family and friends. Even the Lord took time to go away to a quiet place to rest and to pray in the midst of His public ministry. This kind of rest is important for all of us, since it prepares us to come back to our normal schedules in the Fall feeling refreshed and energized. Priests are no different in this regard – we need time to be renewed and continue serving our people.

Since many priests go away simultaneously, it becomes very difficult for us to cover for each other when so many Masses happen around the same time. As always, we do the best we can to serve our parishes with fewer and fewer priests around. With those factors in mind, there will be no 8:30 AM Mass on Fridays during the months of June, July, and August. The Church will remain open during the day for private or group prayer. Those with scheduled Mass intentions on those days will be contacted by our parish office to reschedule.

I know that this change represents an inconvenience to some, but I will count on your patience and understanding as we enter into a restful Summer. As June approaches, I will also publish the Friday Mass times of our neighboring parishes. Additionally, please remember that Adoration and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament will conclude for the Summer months on Tuesday, May 31 as has been the practice for many years. Again, thank you in advance for your understanding!

Finally, I want to update you on the fundraising efforts for our new boiler. I am incredibly grateful for your overwhelming generosity for this urgent need. As of this past week, we have raised a total of \$24,675! This is a significant portion of the \$46,250 needed to complete the project. 
