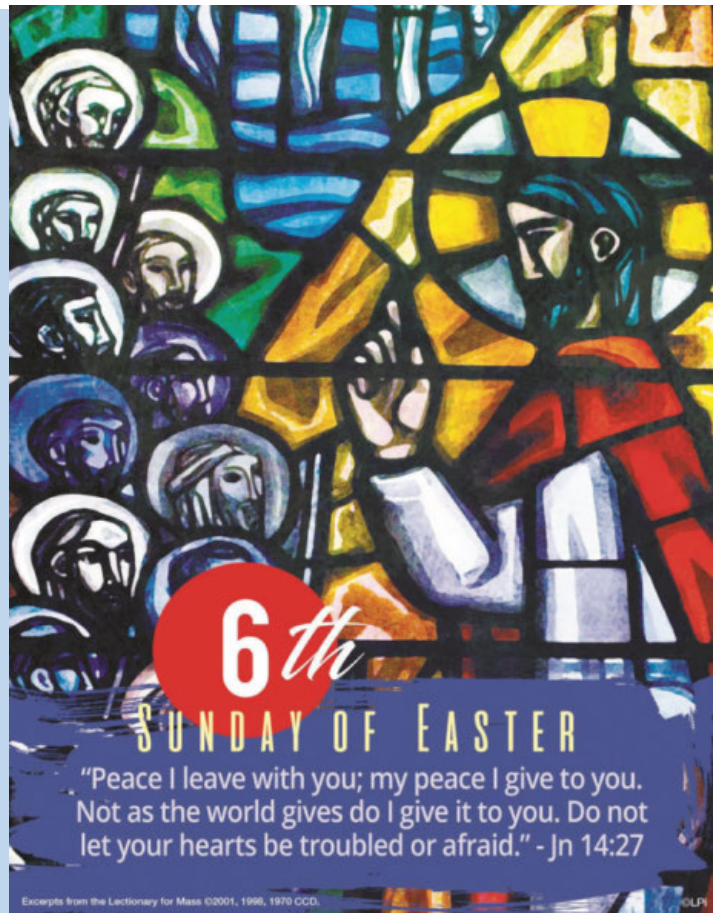

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend's Gospel invites us to trust in the peace that Jesus gives us. The Lord says "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you" – words we hear each time we attend Mass. Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit to His disciples so that they will always be guided and taught the way they should follow. 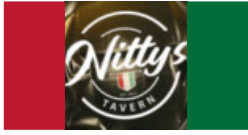
