Dear Friends in Christ,

The Summer is nearly upon us and I know that all of us, in one way or another, are ready for a break! The end of one school year is a time of transition and growth for our students. Many young people are looking forward to elementary school, high school, or college graduation with the joy and expectation of what God has in store for their lives. Please join me in praying for our graduates and all who are preparing to enter into a new part of their life journey. The Church also prepares us for the Summer as we approach "Ordinary Time" and a return to the liturgical color of green. That green represents the slow and steady growth of our Faith that extends all the way until the season of Advent in December.

However, before we reach this long period of "the green season," we celebrate a number of significant Solemnities (solemn celebrations). This past Thursday, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord – the beautiful moment when Jesus returned to Heaven where He sits at the right hand of the Father. This weekend we celebrate the 7th and final Sunday of the Easter. Pentecost will be celebrated next weekend, when we commemorate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and upon us as we officially end the Easter Season. Finally, as Ordinary Time begins, we also celebrate Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi Sunday.

There are so many beautiful theological and spiritual realities to unpack in these important days. I invite all of you to ask God to help you receive all that He wishes to reveal to you as we move through these next weeks. He will certainly guide us to a deeper knowledge and understanding of the Faith we have received.

Finally, please remember that our Summer schedule begins this week. There will be no 8:30 AM Mass on Friday during the months of June, July, and August. Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament will pause until September as well. Masses on Friday mornings at our neighboring parishes are printed in this bulletin. Thank you for your flexibility as the schedule changes! May the Lord bless each of us as the Summer months begin!

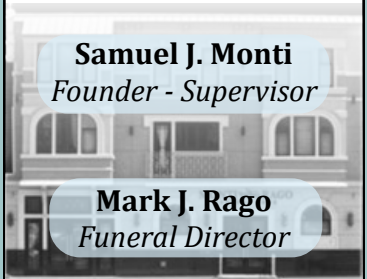
All are invited to share in a very special evening.

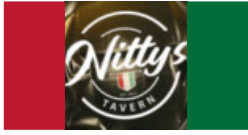
