A Parochial Point


Dear Friends in Christ,

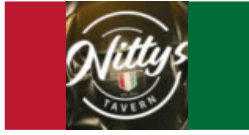
