FROM DEACON'S DESK

UPDATED POLICY AND PROCEDURE FOR THE SCHEDULING AND ADMIN-ISTRATION OF THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

- <u>Effective July 1, 2022</u>, baptisms at Saint Joseph will be scheduled on the <u>4th Sunday</u> of each month. (Note: if you already have a Baptism scheduled, it will not be affected by this change). More than one baptism may be scheduled on any given date.
- Parents who are registered parishioners wishing to have their child baptized in Saint Joseph Church are to contact the parish office to arrange a date. If it is the baptism of a first child, parents will be required to attend a Baptism Preparation Class. Arrangements can be made through the parish office.
- Parents who are not registered parishioners of Saint Joseph must obtain a <u>Letter of Permission</u> from their "proper" (home) pastor. If it is the baptism of a first child, parents must arrange to attend Baptism Preparation Class at their home parish. Proof of completion will be required by Saint Joseph prior to the baptism.




