FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

FULL HOUSE: ACUSHNET VERSION



I am pleased to share that, for the first time in decades, this summer – my last summer – we will have the Acushnet version of Full House, as the rectory will have three of us living there for the service of our parish. Besides myself, we will have Deacon Laurent Valliere and seminarian Christopher Hughes.

Deacon Valliere was with us during the Advent and Christmas season. Originally from Rhode Island, some of our parishioners already knew him from his time as a theology teacher at Bishop Stang High School. His home parish in our diocese is St. Stanislaus in Fall River. Just a couple of weeks ago he and his three classmates were ordained as transitional deacons for our diocese. A transitional deacon is one who is on the path to later being ordained as a priest, while a permanent deacon – as our own Deacon Pepin – is dedicated to that office in a permanent capacity. Deacon Valliere will, God willing, be ordained a priest next summer.

Seminarian **Christopher Hughes** hails from Christ the King Parish in Mashpee and comes to us after completing his second year of theological studies at Immaculate Conception Seminary in Newark, New Jersey. Again, God willing, he has a further two years of studies in preparation for ordination as a priest.

Of course, we continue our prayers for our own seminarian, Lucas da Costa, during these summer months. He has been assigned to Santo Cristo Parish in Fall River for his summer assignment, but we will still look forward to seeing him around here from time to time. He will be beginning his theology studies at St. John's Seminary in Brighton in the Fall.

Please pray for these seminarians, and that others may respond to the call of the Lord to serve His people!





Guidelines for Liturgical Practices Effective 29 May 21

- Indoor seating capacity is increased to 100%; therefore, any previously "roped off" pews will be opened for use. We will continue to keep the side pews "roped off" for parishioners who have not been vaccinated and who are encouraged to maintain physical distance from others.
- Reservations will no longer be necessary from this point on.
- With regard to masks, those who are fully vaccinated are no longer required to wear a mask to attend Mass or any other liturgical or social functions held on parish property. Those who are fully vaccinated are free and welcome to continue to wear masks if you choose to do so. According to the most recent CDC and Commonwealth of Massachusetts guidelines, non-vaccinated persons are advised to continue wearing face masks and to continue distancing until further instructed. We ask you to make the best decision for yourselves while keeping in mind the need for a collective commitment to the common good of our parish community.
- If your child is a Sacristan or Altar Server and has not been vaccinated he/she should continue to wear a mask while serving. We leave it to the parent's discretion whether a child who has been vaccinated should wear a mask while serving.
- Holy Water fonts will be filled with added Holy Salt for purification.
- Pew Missals will once again be placed in the pews.
- Collection baskets will remain at the entrance of the church.
- The elevator will be available.
- Sufficient hand sanitizing dispensers will be made available at the entrance of the church.
- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays remains in effect in the Fall River er Diocese at this time.
