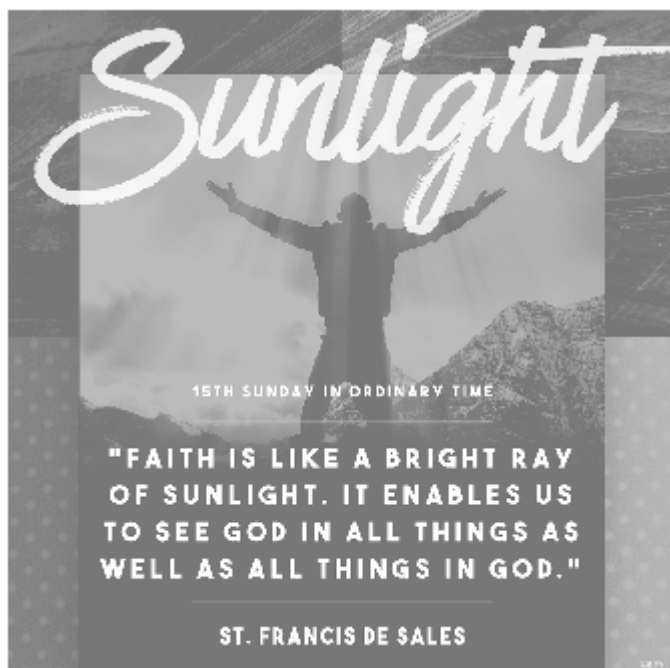

WELCOME BACK - WE'VE MISSED YOU!

Bishop Libasci has announced that restrictions and procedures which have been in place for Masses in this diocese will no longer be in effect including the lifting of the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day Mass. Except for the bringing up of the Gifts, the exchange of the Sign of Peace, and the Distribution of the Precious Blood (all of which shall remain suspended for the time being), the Liturgy will be celebrated as before the pandemic. If you drop this in the collection basket, it is important that you provide your phone number so that you can be contacted if there is any conflict with the date and time you have selected. Also, please be aware that when you see a Mass Intention "For Your Deceased Relatives & Friends", these are from money collected in November from the All Souls Day remembrance envelopes. Your deceased relatives and friends are not only remembered in November but also throughout the year.
