WELCOME BACK - WE'VE MISSED YOU!

Bishop Libasci has announced that restrictions and procedures which have been in place for Masses in this diocese will no longer be in effect including the lifting of the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day Mass. Except for the bringing up of the Gifts, the exchange of the Sign of Peace, and the Distribution of the Precious Blood (all of which shall remain suspended for the time being), the Liturgy will be celebrated as before the pandemic.
