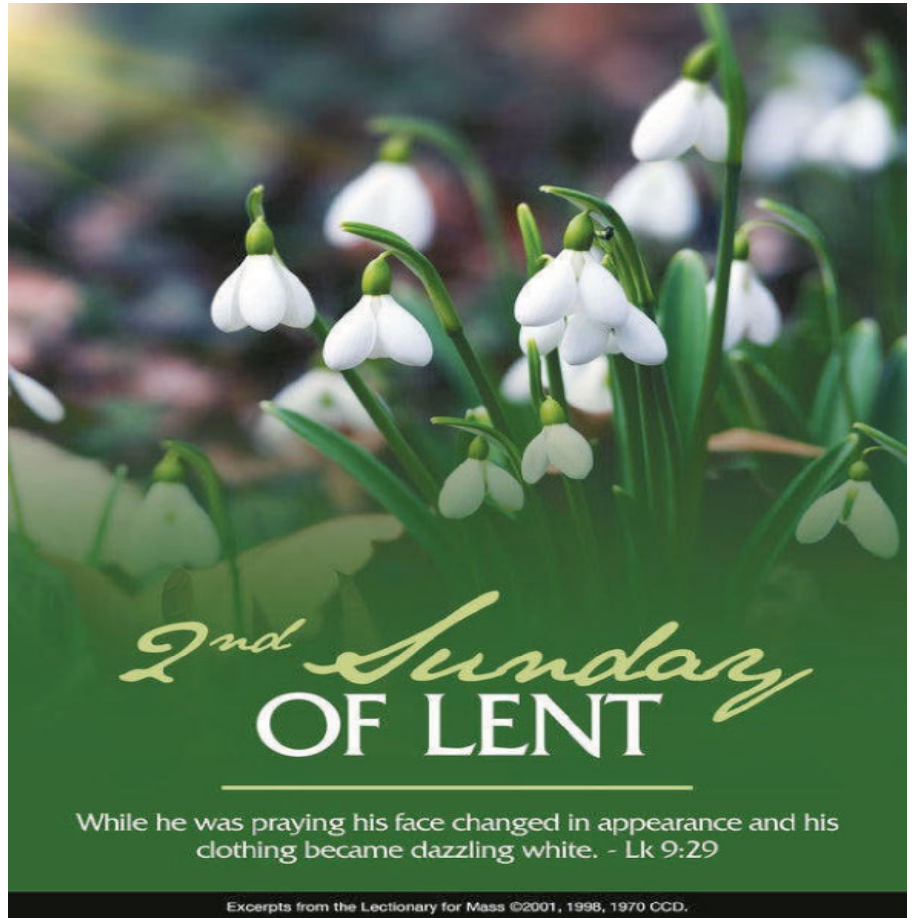

### **Altar Servers Needed**



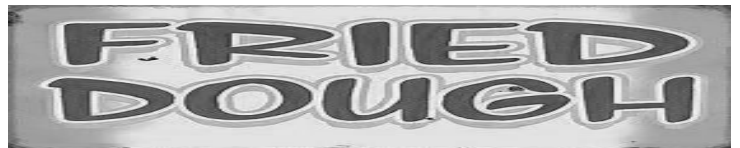
We are currently seeking new Altar Servers to join our team.
