



Letter from Archbishop Blair

I attended a rally at the State Capitol organized to protest Mr. Putin's actions and to mobilize and support, calling attention to the suffering of the people of Ukraine. In many words I told those assembled how we as a church want to heed Pope Francis' request that we devote our prayers and fasting this Lent for the intention of peace for Ukraine. There is nothing that you and I can do on the ground in Ukraine, but we can magnify the public outcry against the invasion. We can contribute materially for the benefits of those who are suffering. At the rally I mentioned that the Knights of Columbus have started a relief fund for Ukraine which you can access on our Archdiocese website. I have made a personal contribution and I encourage you to do so as well.

Let us hope that out of this suffering and injustice a new consciousness of human solidarity may be awakened in peoples everywhere, and that we may not take for granted the freedom and security we enjoy in the United States. In the meantime, let us do everything we can to console, encourage, and support our neighbors of Ukraine ancestry and heritage as well as the people of the suffering land.
