Faith Formation Classes will begin in mid-September. Below is a schedule of when each grade will meet:

Grades 1 & 2 – Mondays from 4:45 – 5:45

Grades 3 & 4 – Tuesdays from 4:45 – 5:45

Grades 5 & 6 – Mondays from 6:00 – 7:00

Grades 7 & 8 – Once a month on Sundays
6:00 – 7:00 p.m.

There is a home-school option for those students with scheduling conflicts.

Homeschooling is **NOT** recommended for students in grades 1 & 2.
