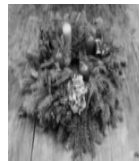


Christmas Pageant

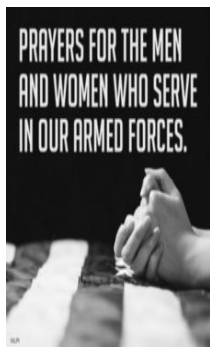
