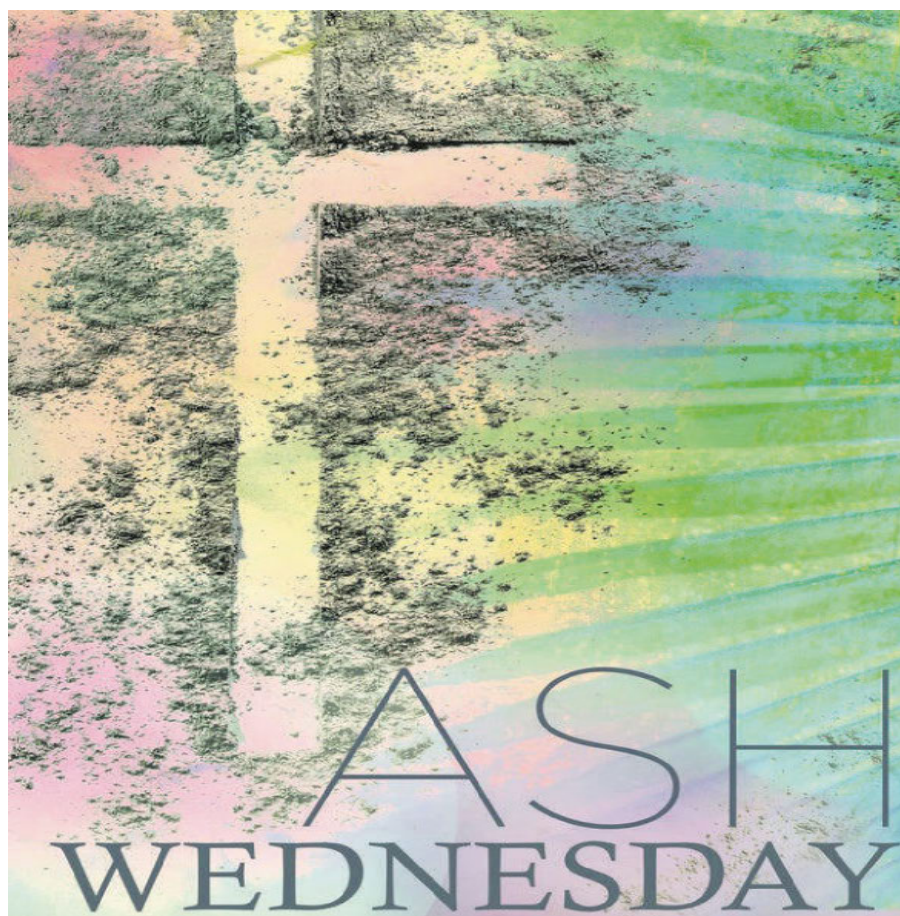

Ashes are made from the burning of the palms which have been blessed last Palm Sunday. Centuries ago it was the custom to sprinkle ashes on public sinners as they went to church to ask for forgiveness. We now publicly acknowledge that we are all sinners and carrying the ashes on our foreheads indicates our willingness to do penance for our sins. The traditional words used as the ashes is placed provide a timely reflection: "Remember, you are dust and to dust you will return."

Fast & Abstinence

For Catholics, there is a obligation to fast (one main meal and two light meals) on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and to abstain from meat. The law of fasting obliges all Catholics, except the sick, between the ages of eighteen and fifty nine. The law of abstinence obliges all Catholics over the age of fourteen. Catholics are also obligated to abstain from meat all Fridays during Lent.

Good stewards realize they really don't own anything. It all belongs to God. It is not so much that God owns them, but they are not ours because we are called to offer them to Him. The reality is that you and I were born naked and with nothing. We will die naked and with nothing. If we really could possess something material, there would be a way to take it with us. But alas, it all slips through our grasp and passes away. And even though all of us came from dust and to dust we will return, through Jesus Christ we will live forever in a perfect state. The only thing we can take with us? Our hearts and whether or not we loved.

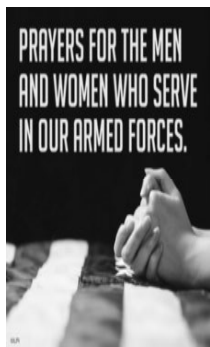

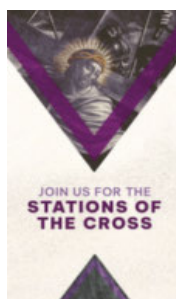

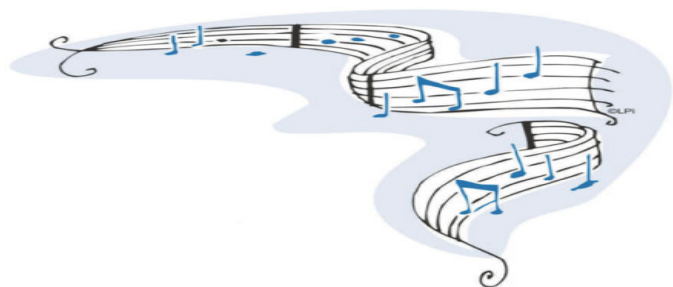
