# Health & Wellness Corner Tip of the Week

#### Do you have any of these symptoms??

- Joint Pain: worse with use, relieved by rest
- Morning Stiffness: stiff joints when you wake
- Joint Tenderness: Joints are tender to touch,
- Limited Joint Motion: reduced range of motion ,can't do a deep knee bend or touch your toes
- Bony Enlargement/Deformity: may be in small joints (fingers & toes) large joints (knees)
- Instability: giving way or buckling of a joint

#### You may have Osteoarthritis

- Tylenol or Motrin (if OK'd by PCP), cold packs or heat may help
- Regular exercise helps unless joint is swollen, warm or red


