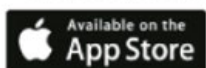

Emergency Medical Services Week 2023

Where Emergency Care Begins

In 1974, President Gerald Ford authorized EMS Week to celebrate EMS practitioners and the important work they do in our nation's communities. This year, May 25th is "Save-A-Life Day" to promote public CPR programs. It doesn't matter how quickly EMS practitioners get to a scene, bystanders will almost always be there first.

Hands-Only CPR can save lives. If you see a teen or adult collapse and is not breathing normally, call 911 and push hard and fast in the center of the chest at a rate of 100 to 120 beats per minute such as in the classic disco song "Stayin' Alive."
