

Winter weather can be dangerous, so it's important to take precautions to stay safe and healthy. Here are some tips to help you prepare for the cold weather:

Prepare your vehicle: Service the radiator and maintain antifreeze level. Check your tires' tread or, if necessary, replace tires with all-weather or snow tires. Keep the gas tank full to avoid ice in the tank and fuel lines. Use a wintertime formula in your windshield washer. Prepare a winter emergency kit to keep in your car in case you become stranded. The kit should include: Cell phone, portable charger, and extra batteries. Items to stay warm, such as extra hats, coats, mittens, blankets, or sleeping bags. Food and water. Booster cables, flares, tire pump, and a bag of sand or cat litter (for traction). Compass and maps. Flashlight, battery-powered radio, and extra batteries.

The Church recalls Our Lord's second manifestation or epiphany which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan. Jesus de-

scended into the river to sanctify its waters and to give them the power to beget sons of God.

In the Eastern Church this feast called *Theophany* because at the baptism of Christ in the River Jordan God appeared in three persons. The baptism of John was a sort of sacramental preparatory for the Baptism of Christ. It moved men to sentiments of repentance and induced them to confess their sins. Christ did not need the baptism of John. Although He appeared in the "substance of our flesh" and was recognized "outwardly like unto ourselves", He was absolutely sinless and impeccable. He conferred upon the water the power of the true Baptism which would remove all the sins of the world: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him Who takes away the sin of the world".

Many of the incidents which accompanied Christ's baptism are symbolical of what happened at our Baptism. At Christ's baptism the Holy Spirit descended upon Him; at our Baptism the Trinity took its abode in our soul. At His baptism Christ was proclaimed the "Beloved Son" of the Father; at our Baptism we become the adopted sons of God. At Christ's baptism the heavens were opened; at our Baptism heaven was opened to us. At His baptism Jesus prayed; after our Baptism we must pray to avoid actual sin.
