




Do you know how to perform CPR?


#### Ash Wednesday Schedule Feb. 14th

Morning Mass with ashes 7:00 a.m.

Ashes only distributed at

12:10, 3:30 & 5:30 p.m.

Ashes have been used for centuries by people of faith to express sorrow and grief for their sins and faults. In the Christian tradition, the wearing of ashes is an external sign of repentance and communicates a desire to follow more closely God's way of love and forgiveness. The practice of receiving ashes is referenced in the Bible on a number of occasions.



## Lenten Tradition of Fast and Abstinence

Catholics, between the ages of 18 – 59, have held the tradition of fasting on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. Fasting means one meatless meal and two smaller meals. Abstaining from meat on all Fridays during Lent is also a Lenten practice for those ages 14 and over.

## An Ash Wednesday Prayer

"Ashes to ashes. Dust to dust." You remind us today, oh Lord, of our origin and end. In the beginning, You fashioned us in the Garden. You dignified dust with the Breath of Life. You made us in Your image and likeness. You led Your people through the dust of the Sinai wilderness to the Promised Land. You overcame temptation in the dry desert.
