Ashes have been used for centuries by people of faith to express sorrow and grief for their sins and faults. In the Christian tradition, the wearing of ashes is an external sign of repentance and communicates a desire to follow more closely God's way of love and forgiveness. The practice of receiving ashes is referenced in the Bible on a number of occasions.

Lenten Tradition of Fast and Abstinence

Catholics, between the ages of 18 – 59, have held the tradition of fasting on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. Fasting means one meatless meal and two smaller meals. Abstaining from meat on all Fridays during Lent is also a Lenten practice for those ages 14 and over.



Saint Valentine was a clergyman in the Roman Empire who ministered to persecuted Christians. He was either a priest or a bishop. He was martyred

and his body buried on the Via Flaminia on February 14. This day has been observed as the Feast of Saint Valentine (Saint Valentine's Day) since at least the eighth century. St. Valentine was also a physician in Rome. He was arrested, condemned to death for his faith, beaten with clubs, and finally beheaded on Feb. 14, AD 270.


