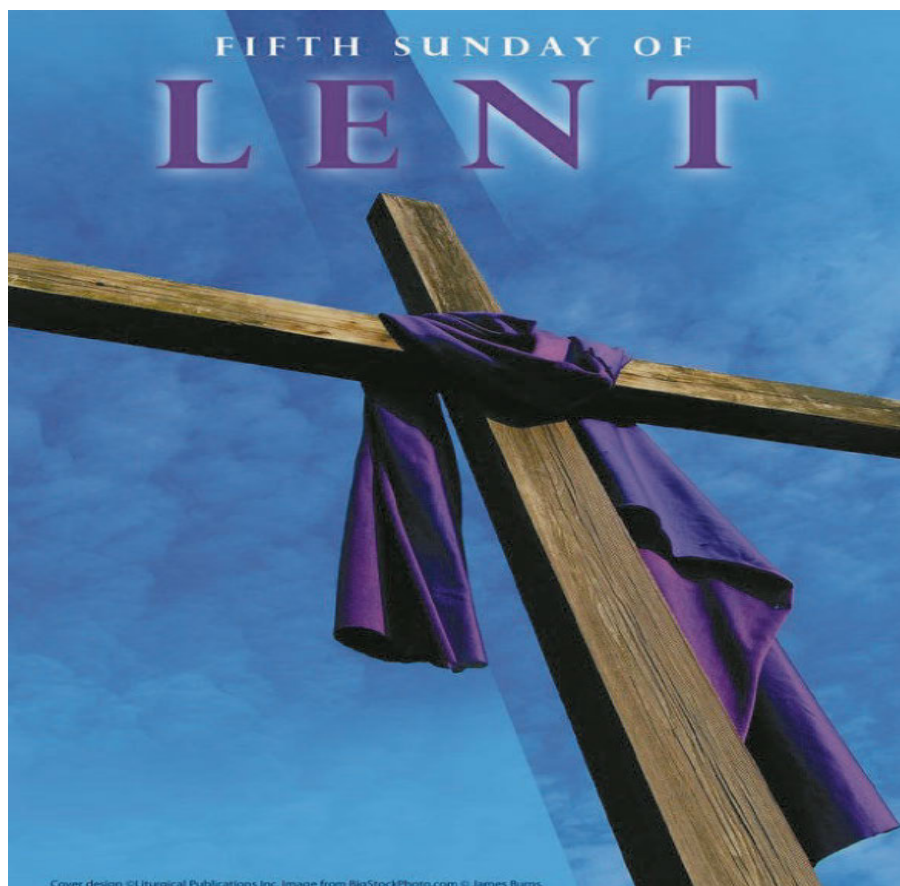

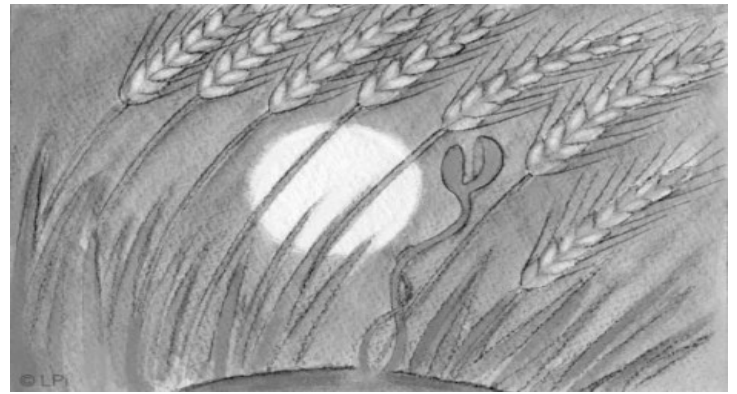

Do you or someone you know have Hearing Loss?

Consequences of untreated hearing loss:

Being left out of conversations
Feeling isolated
In children- delayed language development & socialization
In adults hearing loss significantly contributes to increased cost for health care
May contribute to faster atrophy in the brain
Increased risk of falling
Increased hospitalizations

People with hearing loss have:

50% increased risk of developing dementia
40% increased risk of developing depression
20% less likely to participate in social activities

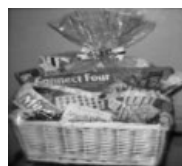
